Order

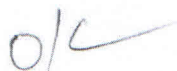
WHEREAS Jagannath Jain College, At/Po - Jhumari Telaiya, Dist - Koderma, Jharkhand - 825409 (Code No. APE00425) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 07.09.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2005-2006 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (i) The institution will ensure that Principal/Head and at least 07 (seven) faculty members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position for an intake of 100 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent the Eastern Regional Committee within one month of the commencement of the course.
- (ii) The institution shall submit a list of teaching staff duly countersigned by the competent authority of the University within one month of the commencement of the course.
- (iii) The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by State Govt./UGC.
- (iv) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (five years) in a Nationalized Bank to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- (v) The institution shall create a Reserve fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the teachers and staff within one month from the date of issue of this order and maintain in the form of FDR in favour of the management of the institution for a period of not less than sixty months (five years) in a Nationalized Bank.
- (vi) The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.

2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P. (PIL) No. 327 of 2011 has been filed by Shiv Shankar Munda - Vs - Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hqrs., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hqrs. issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide letter dated 01.05.2014 with the following observations:-

- (i) The institution does not fulfill the prescribed norms regarding infrastructural and instructional facilities.
- (ii) The institution does not adhered to the norms regarding maintenance of endowment ad reserve fund.
- (iii) The institution does not fulfill the prescribed norms regarding engagement of teaching and other staff.
- (iv) The institution has not been able to run the programme effectively.

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3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had not submitted any representation in response to deficiency letter dated 01.05.2014 within the stipulated period to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 172nd Meeting held on 17th June 2014 considered the matter and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26853 dt. 27.06.2014 for compliance of the above deficiencies pointed out by NCTE Hqrs.

4. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representations dated 23.07.2014 in response to show cause notice dated 27.06.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 174th Meeting held on 5th August 2014 considered the representation of the institution and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26917 dated 13.08.2014 on the following grounds:-

- (i) The institution has not submitted any proposal for shifting of the B.Ed. Dept in the new building constructed by the Dept.
- (ii) Before granting the recognition to the institution, the principal of the college has given an undertaking to the effect that he would move the authorities to demarcate 5 acre of land from the available land of college for B.Ed. section exclusively.
- (iii) During Special inspection of the college conducted on 23.10.2013 revealed that the B.Ed. course is conducted in a portion of the building of the General College namely the Jagannath Jain College. Only two classrooms, one language lab and one office room aggregating to a total area of around 2334 Sq. ft. are exclusively available for conducting the B.Ed. course as against the requirement of a minimum of 1500 Sq. Mts. as per the prescribed NCTE norms. All other facilities are shared with the General College. Thus, the available infrastructure facilities are inadequate for conducting B.Ed. course as per the prescribed NCTE norms. The construction of the new building is under process which would be completed & is likely to be completed by the end of this financial year.
- (iv) Original FDRs of Rs. 5.00 lakh & Rs. 3.00 lakh in the joint name of the institution and RD, ERC, Bhubaneswar not submitted.
- (v) The institution has not appointed the vacant post of teaching faculty. The existing faculty are also on contractual basis till date.
- (vi) No regular HOD appointed by the institution till date.
- (vii) The institution has not submitted the fresh faculty list duly approved by the Registrar of the concerned university.

5. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representations dated 17.09.2014 in response to show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 13.08.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 176th Meeting held on 09.10.2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hqrs. as well as the reply submitted by the institution. The matter was discussed in detail and observed that the institution is still having the following deficiencies which are contravened to the Norms and Standards prescribed in the Regulations of NCTE:-

- (i) The institution has not submitted any proposal for shifting of the B.Ed. Dept in the new building constructed by the Dept.
- (ii) Before granting the recognition to the institution, the principal of the college has given an undertaking to the effect that he would move the authorities to demarcate 5 acre of land from the available land of college for B.Ed. section exclusively.

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- (iii) During Special inspection of the college conducted on 23.10.2013 revealed that the B.Ed. course is conducted in a portion of the building of the General College namely the Jagannath Jain College. Only two classrooms, one language lab and one office room aggregating to a total area of around 2334 Sq. ft. are exclusively available for conducting the B.Ed. course as against the requirement of a minimum of 1500 Sq. Mts. as per the prescribed NCTE norms. All other facilities are shared with the General College. Thus, the available infrastructure facilities are inadequate for conducting B.Ed. course as per the prescribed NCTE norms. The construction of the new building is under process which likely to be completed by the end of this financial years.
- (iv) Original FDRs of Rs. 5.00 lakh & Rs. 3.00 lakh in the joint name of the institution and RD, ERC, Bhubaneswar not submitted.
- (v) The institution has not appointed teaching faculty against the vacant post as required as per NCTE norms. The existing faculty are also on contractual basis till date.
- (vi) No regular HOD is appointed by the institution till date.
- (vii) The institution has not submitted the fresh faculty list duly approved by the Registrar of the concerned university.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

The Committee concluded that the institution is running the B.Ed. course violating the NCTE Norms and Regulation 2009. The Committee, therefore, decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2015-2016.

5. **NOW, THEREFORE, grant of recognition to Jagannath Jain College, At/Po - Jhumari Telaiya, Dist - Koderma, Jharkhand - 825409 (Code No. APE00425) for B.Ed. course is hereby withdrawn from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.**

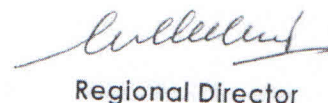
