## Order

WHEREAS Anand Shankar Rotary B.Ed. College, Vill - Chainpur, PO - Chainpur, City - Daltonganj, Dist - Palamu, Jharkhand - 822101 (Code No. APE00964) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 31.08.2009 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2009-2010 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Eastern Regional Committee.
- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended form time to time.
- (iii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- 2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P. (PIL) No. 327 of 2011 has been filed by Shiv Shankar Munda Vs Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hars., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hars. issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No. 93-108/2014/NCTE/Insp./A87021 dated 30.04.2014 with the following observations:-
  - (i) In spite of prior intimation, the institution did not ensure presence of the staff and students for interaction with the inspection team. The institution is advised to be niglact on such matters in the future.
  - (ii) The institution is deficient in respect of both infrastructural and instructional facilities.
  - (iii) In spite of instructions from the affiliating University, the institution has not converted the FDRs in respect of Endowment and Reserve fund into joint accounts with Regional Director, ERC.
  - (iv) The institution has not adhered to the prescribed norms regarding engagement of staff and their service conditions. Two vacant positions of lecturer have not been filled.
  - (v) The institution has not been able to organize instructional programme properly.

- 3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representation dated 03.06.2014 in response to deficiency letter dated 30.04.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 172nd Meeting held on 17th June 2014 considered the representation of the institution and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, clarification letter to the institution was issued vide No. 26535 dated 26.06.2014 on the following grounds:-
  - (i) Staff room, common room for boys and girls, Principal room are not available.
  - (ii) Multipurpose hall is 1430 sq.ft. only which is less than the required 2000 sq.ft.
  - (iii) The list of faculty duly approved by the Registrar of the concerned university is not submitted.
  - (iv) The institution must intimate the change of staff to ERC, NCTE for information.
  - (v) Affiliation order issued from the concerned university is to be submitted.
- 4. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representations dated 01.08.2014 in response to clarification letter dated 26.06.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 175th Meeting held on 9th September 2014 considered the representation of the institution and as decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 27310 dated 19.09.2014 on the following grounds:-
  - (i) Staff room, common room for boys and girls, Principal room are not available. The institution has not submitted the documentary proof like CD showing the whole area of the building and existence of the above referred rooms.
  - (ii) Multipurpose hall is 1430 Sq. ft. only which is less than the required 2000 Sq. ft. The institution has not submitted revised building plan showing the extended area of the multipurpose hall and duly approved by any Govt Engineer.
  - (iii) The list of faculty duly approved by the Registrar of the concerned university is not submitted.
  - 5. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representations dated 14.10.2014 in response to show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 19.09.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 177th Meeting held on 18th November 2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hars, as well as the reply submitted by the institution. The matter was discussed in detail and observed that the institution is still having the following deficiencies which are contravened to the Norms and Standards prescribed in the Regulations of NCTE:-
    - (i) Staff room, common room for boys and girls, Principal room are not available.
    - (ii) Multipurpose hall is 1430 Sq. ft only which is less than the required 2000 sq. ft. as per submitted.
    - (iii) As per submitted faculty list part-time lecturer for fine Arts/Music and Physical Education is not qualified as per NCTE norms.

## In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

The Committee concluded that the institution is running the B.Ed. course violating the NCTE Norms and Regulation 2009. The Committee, therefore, decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2015-2016.

6. NOW, THEREFORE, grant of recognition to Anand Shankar Rotary B.Ed. College, Vill - Chainpur, PO - Chainpur, City - Daltonganj, Dist - Palamu, Jharkhand - 822101 (Code No. APE00964) for B.Ed. course is hereby withdrawn from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.
