### CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, Sri Guru Ramdass College of Education Pandher, Plot No.-21//16 (8-0), 34//5, Street No.- FGC Road, Village- Pandher, P.O.-Kotla Gujran, Via Chetanpura, Tehsil/Taluka - Majitha, Town/City - Amritsar, District -Amritsar, State – Punjab-143606 was granted recognition for B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order F.No.NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-9392/238th (1st Sitting) Meeting/2015/104351-55 dated 25.05.2015, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before NRC in its 416th meeting of NRC held on 20th December, 2023 and the Committee decided as under:

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, directions received from Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 17369 of 2023 vide Order dated 03.10.2023 and guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee. The NRC made the following observations: -

The Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana in CWP No. 17369 of 2023 passed an Order dated 03.10.2023 and directed to constitute the necessary committee for inspection of colleges and take up the issue relating to grant of recognition in the states of Punjab and Haryana on urgent basis. The Hon'ble Court further directed us to submit a detailed report in this regard before it.

In compliance with the above directions of the Hon'ble Court, the NCTE conducted an inspection of the institution u/s 13 of NCTE Act, 1993 and considered the report in this meeting ..... "

In view of the above, the NRC observed the certain deficiencies as per the Visiting Team Report and decided to issue First Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993, before withdrawal of recognition of B.Ed. courses. The institution is directed to submit its reply with all supporting documents within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of SCN.

Accordingly, First Show Cause was issued on 19.01.2024 and the reply from the institution was received in NRC on 15.01.2024.

AND WHEREAS, the said reply was considered by the NRC in its 422nd (Part-2) meeting of 3. NRC held on 6th and 07th June, 2024 and the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued on certain grounds under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice, before withdrawal of recognition.

Accordingly, Final Show Cause was issued on 03.08.2024 and the reply from the institution was received in NRC on 25.09.2024.

**4. AND WHEREAS,** the said reply was considered by the NRC in its 433<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2025 and the Committee decided as under: -

"The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee noted the following: -

• The Committee considered the reply dated 09.08.2024 submitted by the institution received in NRC on 25.09.2024 in reply to Final Show Cause Notice issued to it and observed that the reply of the institution is satisfactory.

Hence, the Committee decided that no action is required to be taken, and the status quo of the institution be maintained as recognized for offering B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students i.e. two units of 50 students each. Continuation Order may be issued accordingly."

- 5. NOW THEREFORE, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE decided that the institution namely Sri Guru Ramdass College of Education Pandher, Plot No.-21//16 (8-0), 34//5, Street No.-FGC Road, Village- Pandher, P.O.- Kotla Gujran, Via Chetanpura, Tehsil/Taluka Majitha, Town/City Amritsar, District Amritsar, State Punjab-143606 be allowed for continuing recognition for conducting B.Ed. programme of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students i.e. two basic units of 50 students each.
- 6. If the Institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations, and orders made thereunder, the action including withdrawal of recognition shall be taken by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
