ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Vansha Devi Degree College, Village- Gazadharpur, Post- Gaddopur, Tehsil- Badlapur, District- Jaunpur-22202, Uttar Pradesh had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for B.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred Only) students on 29.12.2007.

AND WHEREAS, the deficiency letter issued to the institution on 23.12.2008 and the reply of the institution (in response to deficiency letter) was considered by the committee in its 139th Meeting held from March 10th to 12th April, 2009 and committee decided to close the file. Accordingly, closer letter was issued to the institution on 04.06.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 05.06.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order. The Council vide order dated 07.08.2009 and accept the appeal and set aside NRC's order dated 04.06.2009 and remand back the case to NRC for taking necessary action including causing of inspection of the institution to ascertain the availability of infrastructure and instructional facilities as per norms and thereafter pass appropriate orders.

AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 11.02.2010 and the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit, input received from the visiting team in the form of report/ videography and the input received from recommendation of the State Government, the Northern Regional Committee in its 158th Meeting held from 19th to 22nd April, 2010 and NRC decided to issue show cause notice on the certain points. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 11.05.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the considered by the NRC, in its 162nd meeting held from 24th to 27th June, 2010 and committee decided to close the file and return FDRs if submitted. Accordingly, closer letter was issued to the institution on 16.07.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 08.07.2010 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order. The Council vide order dated 28.09.2010 and accept the the appeal and reverse the order dated 16.07.2010 of NRC with a direction to issue letter of intent prior to grant of recognition under the provisions of clause 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations within 15 days of issue of appellate order. Accordingly, under clause 7(9) was issued to the institution on 10.11.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply dated 05.01.2011 w.r.t. Letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations 2009 was considered by the NRC in its 177th meeting held from January 27th to 29th, 2010 and committee decided that the clarification. Accordingly, clarification letter was issued to the institution on 18.02.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the Institution dated 21.02.2011 has been considered by the NRC in its 180th meeting held from 23rd March to 26th March, 2011, 31st March to 1st April and 9th April to 11th April 2011 and committee decided that the clarify.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the institution dated 25.08.2011 & 28.05.2011 and the original file was considered by NRC in its 183rd (2nd setting) Meeting held from 08th to 14th June, 2011 and NRC decided that the Formal Recognition order under clause 7(11) of the NCTE Regulation, 2009 for 100 seats in B.Ed. course for the session 2011-2012 be issued to the institution.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Vansha Devi Degree College, Village- Gazadharpur, Post- Gaddopur, Tehsil- Badlapur, District- Jaunpur-22202, Uttar Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. One year Course with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred Only) students from the academic session 2011-2012 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:

- The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated alongwith an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

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- iii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009.

Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc. wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institutio failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued, there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993.
