Sub:- Compliance of decision of NRC in its 379th Meeting (Virtual) held on 30th September, 2022.

Sir/Madam,

The recognition was granted by the Northern Regional Committee to **Shree Ram College of Education, National Highway, Opposite Mela Restaurant, Gajraula (J.P. Nagar), Moradabad Road, Uttar Pradesh** vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-1838/53084-5331 dated 01.09.2006 with an annual intake of 100 seats. In light of NCTE Regulations, 2014 revised recognition order No. NRC/NCTE/UP-1838/2015/148150-55 dated 02.05.2015 for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of one units of 50 students each was issued to the institution.

2. The recognition was withdrawn to the institution for B.Ed. course for an intake of 100 seats (two units of 50 students each) from the end of the next academic session 2022-2023 vide Order No.- NRC/NCTE/UP-1838/338th Meeting/2021/215063-69 dated 07.08.2021.

3. The institution has filed Cont Cas (C) 933/2022 in the High Court of Delhi. The Hon'ble High Court disposed of this contempt petition vide order dated 05/09/2022 on the instructions of Counsel appearing for NRC, NCTE that the necessary communication dated 30/03/2022 has been sent in compliance of order dated 21/03/2022 in the W.P. (C) 4527/2022 to the concerned University.

4. The institution has filed other contempt petition No. Cont. Cas (C) 1047/2022 submitting that the NRC in communication dated 30/03/2022 has only made reference to the withdrawal order issued to the petitioner institution and did not clarify anything regarding the updated/recognized position of the petitioner regarding its eligibility for participating in the counselling process 2022-2023.

5. The Hon'ble High Court disposed of the contempt petition vide order dated 28/09/2022 with the direction "After some hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be making a representation to the respondents to issue a clarificatory communication, clarifying that the petitioner is eligible to participate in the counselling for the Academic Session 2022-2023. Let the petitioner made the said representation, pursuant to which the respondents may issue the communication, as requested by the petitioner. The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of".

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6. The matter was considered by NRC in its 379th Meeting (Virtual) held on 30th September, 2022 and the Committee decided to issue a letter clarifying that the institution is allowed to participate in the counselling for the academic session 2022-2023 but, the withdrawal order No. NRC/NCTE/UP-1838/338th meeting/2021/215063-69 dated 07/08/2021 stands valid except the change in academic session only.

The affiliating University/ State Govt. may accordingly be informed.

7. In compliance of above Hon'ble High Court Order, it is clarified that the said institution is entitled to participate in counselling and admit students for the academic session 2022-2023.

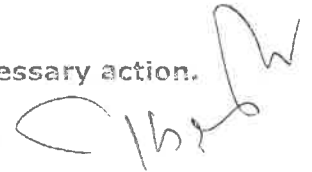
