RESTORATION ORDER

12 OCT 2023

WHEREAS, the recognition under section 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Pandit Laxmi Narayan Memorial Mahvidyalaya, Village – Tappal, Post office – Gharbara, Tehsil – Khair, District – Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed.** Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred) from the academic session 2009-2010 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-3448/157/Meeting/2010/18904-18909 dated 26.03.2010.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the revised recognition was issued to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/UP-Common Orders/2015/115484-510 dated 09.06.2015.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, as per decision of NRC in its 337th (Virtual Mode) Meeting held on 08th to 09th July, 2021 the recognition was withdrawn to the institution for B.Ed. course from the end of the academic session 2022-2023 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/NRC/NCTE/UP-3448/337th Meeting/2021/214652-57 dated 16.07.2021.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed an appeal in the NCTE Hqrs New Delhi under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 against withdrawal order dated 16.07.2021. The appeal committee passed an order dated 26.11.2021 and confirm the order appealed against.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed W.P.(C) 15136/2021 & CM APPL 27980/2022 High Court of Delhi at New Delhi. The High Court of Delhi passed an order dated 26.05.2023, as per the directions of Hon'ble Court vide order dated 26.05.2023, the matter was considered by NRC in its 400th meeting held on 09th June, 2023 and VT was constituted after receiving an amount of Rs. 1.5 Lakhs. The VT was conducted and as per the directions of the court vide order dated 26.06.2023, the VT Report was submitted before the Hon'ble Court. The matter was placed before NRC in its 408th (Blended Mode) meeting held on 16th & 17th August, 2023 and committee decided as under :-

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC in light of court order dated 08/08/2023 passed in W.P.(C) No. 15136/2021 and the Committee observed following:

- That vide order dated 26/05/2023 the Hon'ble High Court directed the NRC to conduct inspection of the institution.
- The NRC in its 400th Meeting held on 9th June 2023 decided to constitute VT and the inspection was conducted.


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- As per the directions of the Hon'ble Court the inspection report was submitted before the Hon'ble court.

The Hon'ble court vide order dated 08/08/2023 remanded the matter back to NRC and set aside the withdrawal order dated 16/07/2021 and the order of the appeal committee dated 26/11/2021. The court further directed to NRC to pass appropriate order after providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to the petitioner institution.

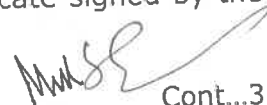
- The Court further directed the NRC to restore the petitioner institution's recognition of the academic year 2023-2024 and allowed the petitioner to participate in the counselling process for the academic session 2023-2024.

In view of the above the NRC decided the following:

- **The recognition for B.Ed. course of the petitioner institution be restored.**
- **The petitioner institution is allowed to participate in the counselling process for the academic session 2023-2024**

The NRC also decided **that First Show Cause Notice Under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice on the following grounds:**

- The institution is required to submit proof / evidence to prove that it is a Multi-disciplinary institution as per clause 2(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- The institution is required to submit Certified registered land documents issued by the Registering Authority
- The institution is required to submit Blue print of approved Building plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well other infrastructural facilities such as class rooms etc.
- The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to use the land for educational purpose.
- The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
- The institution is required to submit Certified copy of site plan with demarcated land area for running different courses.
- The institution is required to submit Building safety certificate from the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit Fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit Building Completion Certificate signed by the Competent Government Authority.


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- The institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative-not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs. 100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/ap-pointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
- The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty members.
- The institution is required to submit copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts National-ized/ Scheduled Bank towards Endowment & Reserve Fund in the joint operation mode with RD, NRC, NCTE & Management along with duly filled Bank Form "A" in original, verified/ signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- The institution is required to submit downloaded copies of documents from the web-site of the institution with hyperlinks of the same as per provisions of 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- The institution has not adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up to date information on its official website as per NCTE Regulations 8(14) condition for grant of recognitions as per NCTE Regulations 2014.

The NRC further decided that an intimation will be sent to the Management of the petitioner institution to remain present before the NRC in the next meeting of NRC along with reply of the First SCN.

Accordingly, letter was issued to the institution and other concerned on 30.08.2023.

Accordingly, first Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 was issued to the institution on 30.08.2023.

6. **AND WHEREAS,** the institution has submitted reply dated 15.09.2023 of the first show cause notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 received in NRC office on 15.09.2023. The matter was considered by NRC in its 411th (Blended Mode) meeting held on 15th September, 2023 and the committee decided as under:

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC in light of court order dated 08/08/2023 passed in W.P.(C) No. 15136/2021 and the Committee observed following:

- That vide order dated 26/05/2023 the Hon'ble High Court directed the NRC to conduct inspection of the institution.
- The NRC in its 400th Meeting held on 9th June 2023 decided to constitute VT and the inspection was conducted.
- As per the directions of the Hon'ble Court the inspection report was submitted before the Hon'ble court.


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- The Hon'ble court vide order dated 08/08/2023 remanded the matter back to NRC and set aside the withdrawal order dated 16/07/2021 and the order of the appeal committee dated 26/11/2021. The court further directed to NRC to pass appropriate order after providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to the petitioner institution.
- The Court further directed the NRC to restore the petitioner institution's recognition of the academic year 2023-2024 and allowed the petitioner to participate in the counselling process for the academic session 2023-2024.

The NRC in its 408th meeting restore the recognition of the institution and issued SCN to the institution. Accordingly, SCN was issued to the institution on 30/08/2023 and also directed that the Authorized representative of the institution be present before the committee.

The institution has submitted reply of SCN dated 30/08/2023 vide letter dated 11/09/2023. Shri Ajay Kumar Sharma, Principal of institution attended the this meeting as Authorized representative of the institution and presented his case along with the reply of the SCN.

The NRC heard the Authorized representative and considered the reply of the institution. The committee decided to restore the recognition for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units).

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Pandit Laxmi Narayan Memorial Mahvidyalaya, Village – Tappal, Post office – Gharbara, Tehsil – Khair, District – Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh** restore the recognition for **B.Ed.** course for two-years duration with an annual intake of 100 (**two basic units**) of **50 students each** subject to fulfilment of the following :-

- (i) The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- (iii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

8. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

10. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Northern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional

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facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- (a) Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution.
 - (b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - (c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
 - (d) Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - (e) Fee charged from students;
 - (f) Available infrastructural facilities;
 - (g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - (h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - (i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - (j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - (k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
11. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
12. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
13. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Northern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
