PUBLIC NOTICE

Please refer to the earlier Public Notices dated 09.09.2024 regarding the online submission of Performance Appraisal Reports (PAR) for the academic session(s) 2021-2022 & 2022-2023, and the subsequent extension notices dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024.

2. The General Body (GB) of the NCTE in its 68th (Emergent) Meeting held on 25.11.2025 has approved the reopening of the online PAR portal as a final, one-time opportunity for submission of PAR for the academic session 2021-22 and 2022-23 by the following Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs):

- (i) TEIs Recognized up to Academic Session 2021-22: Must submit PAR for both 2021-22 and 2022-23
- (ii) TEIs Recognized in Academic Session 2022-23: Must submit PAR for 2022-23 only.
- (iii) TEIs Recognized in/after 2023-24: Are not required to submit PAR for the specific cycle.

3. The General Body further resolved that access to the PAR portal shall be restricted to those TEIs whose recognition status is 'Active', or 'under judicial stay' including cases where the withdrawal order has been quashed by a competent court or is presently under a 'judicial stay'. In respect of TEIs whose recognition stands 'Withdrawn' on account of non-submission of PAR till 31.12.2024, such institutions may avail this final opportunity only upon obtaining an order of restoration or stay from a competent legal authority i.e. the Hon'ble High Court or the NCTE Appellate Committee under section 18 before the closing date of the portal window.

4. The Council further directed the NCTE Appellate Committee to hear and dispose of appeals filed by such defaulting TEIs seeking restoration on a fast-track basis.

5. The Council approved the following fee structure for this window:

- New Submission: TEIs submitting PAR for the first time shall pay the processing fee as prescribed in the 2024 Public Notice (i.e. Rs. 15000/- + GST for Private TEIs and Rs. 5000/- + GST for Government TEIs, per academic session)
- Re-submission/Revision: TEIs that have already submitted their PAR but wish to update or revise their data shall be allowed to do so without payment of any additional fee.

6. The resolution of the General Body meeting of NCTE was placed before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi where related matters were pending consideration. Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in its order dated 15.12.2025 passed in W.P.(C) No. 5369/2025 and connected matters gave the following directions:

- i. NCTE will appoint 04 dedicated Nodal Officers, one for each Regional Committee (RC) who will assist the TEIs in updating contact details, resolving portal related technical issues, if any, faced by the TEIs.
- ii. NCTE will give a public notice giving three weeks' time for TEIs to update their mobile number and e-mail IDs.

7. In strict compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and following the completion of the exercise of passing orders of restoration of recognition in each case, including them in the list of recognized institutions maintained on the website of NCTE, and communicating the updated status to the concerned State Government and Affiliating Body/University, a period of three weeks from 27.03.2026 to 16.04.2026 is hereby granted to these TEIs to update their mobile numbers and email IDs on the Institute Contact Update Portal available on the NCTE website.

8. The following Nodal Officers have been appointed for each of the four Regional Committees to assist the TEIs in updating contact details, resolving portal-related technical issues, if any faced by the TEIs:

9. Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in its order dated 15.12.2025 passed in W.P.(C) No. 5369/2025 and connected matters gave the following further directions:

- i) NCTE will give another Public Notice giving six weeks' time for opening of portal for submission of PAR to TEIs whose recognition status has been restored on the basis of a order of competent legal authority and
- ii) TEIs who have already submitted their PAR but wish to update or revise their data shall be allowed to do so without payment of any additional fee. It shall be option of the TEIs to submit any further particulars of their PAR in addition to the PAR details which have already been uploaded.
- iii) In so far as the TEIs which were recognized, but were not affiliated by the concerned affiliating body, they need not submit PAR for the years for which they were not so affiliated.

11. Accordingly, following the up-dation of contact details by the TEIs on the NCTE portal (ICUP), another Public Notice shall be issued providing a six-week window for both submission of new PAR details as well as revision of PAR details already submitted by the concerned TEIs for the Academic Sessions 2021–22 and 2022–23. Those TEIs who have already submitted PAR but wish to update or revise their PAR submission shall be allowed to do so during this six-week window without payment of any additional fee. Such TEIs shall also be given an opportunity to update their contact details (mobile numbers and email IDs) if they so desire, during the six-week window.

10. The Council has reiterated that the submission of PAR is mandatory for the continuation of recognition and any TEIs that fail to submit PAR within this final stipulated window shall be liable for appropriate action being instituted against it in terms of Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 for withdrawal of its recognition.
