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PUBLIC NOTICE

National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), a Statutory Body established by an Act of Parliament (No. 73 of 1993) under the Administrative control of Ministry of Education, Govt. of India with an objective to bring more transparency and improvement in the Teacher Education System in the country is in the process of strengthening /updating the existing Online Visiting Team Panel/Database of academicians/architects who have the requisite experience & expertise in the field for conducting inspections of Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) through Virtual Mode in accordance with the existing provisions under the NCTE Act/Rules/Regulations and Visiting Team Policy.

2. As per existing Visiting Team Policy of NCTE, the detailed Eligibility Criteria for submitting application for selection/empanelment of Experts as VT Member is stipulated in **Annexure-A**.

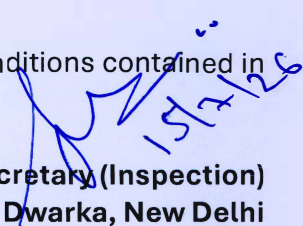
3. The applications from the willing and eligible experts (both Academicians and Architects) fulfilling the above requisite criteria are invited for empanelment as Visiting Team Member to conduct online inspections of the TEIs under the relevant sections of NCTE Act 1993. The applications may be submitted online through NCTE Website on the dedicated Portal by visiting URL Link **https://web.ncte.gov.in/misc/vt_team_app/index.php** on or before **27th July, 2026**. In case of not fulfilling any of the eligibility criteria, the application shall be summarily rejected.

4. The applications containing credentials of the applicant should be verified and recommended by the Registrar/Head of the Department of the University / Principal of the Govt. College and forward the same to NCTE through online portal.

5. It may be noted that the applicants those holding the post (as Academicians) in **Level-13 and above** besides the existing criteria for empanelment as expert of VT Member may only apply. The application submitted offline or any other mode shall not be accepted.

6. Merely submission of application does not confer the rights/guarantee for selection.

7. NCTE reserves all rights to cancel or modify any of the conditions contained in the Public Notice without assigning any reason.

Annexure-A

1. Eligibility for Academicians (Teacher Educators / Educational Administrators)

- **Current Status:** Must be a serving Government Teacher Educator or Educational Administrator.
- **Age Limit:** Must not be more than 55 years of age.
- **Experience:** A minimum of 5 years of experience is required.
- **Pay Level :** Academicians must hold a post in Level-13 or above.
- **Technical Proficiency:** Must have a working knowledge of computer applications/ICT and be able to adhere to the requirements of the NCTE online VT module.

2. Eligibility for Architects

- Nominations for empanelment as VT Members may be received from the Central/ State Govt. Institutions/Council of Architecture.
- **Technical Proficiency:** Similar to academicians, they must be capable of using the online VT module and ICT applications.

3. Mandatory General Criteria for All VT Members (Academicians and Architects)

All experts empanelled for the Visiting Team must satisfy the following conditions:

- **Integrity:** Their integrity must be beyond doubt. They (and their family members) must have no direct or indirect interest, stake, or share in the running or administration of the institution being inspected.
 - **Legal Standing:** They must not have any Vigilance or CBI criminal case pending or contemplated against them, nor any proceedings that debar them from nomination.
 - **Objectivity:** They must demonstrate the ability to make objective judgments based on facts and in conformity with NCTE Acts, Rules, and Regulations, rather than subjective impressions.
 - **Reporting Skills:** They must be able to write precise and unambiguous reports without inconsistency.
 - **Ethics:** They are strictly prohibited from accepting any gifts, honorarium, fees, or hospitality from the institution or any individual related to it.
4. Remuneration/TA/DA/Sitting Fee shall be paid as per NCTE Act/Rules/Regulations.
