WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Ravoof & Vazir Khans Memorial College of Education, S.No.278/3, P.No.67-83, chapuram Panchayat, Srikakulam District, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Vazir Khan Memorial Educational Society**. vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2007-2008/13590 dt. 26.10.2007 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2007-2008.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. a revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a corrigendum vide order dated 22.06.2015 permitting the institution to have one basic unit of 50 students.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 368th meeting held on 08th – 09th January 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice U/s 17 of NCTE Act 1993 to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 18.01.2019. The institution submitted reply vide letter dated 30.01.2019 and 13.02.2019.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 373rd meeting held on 26th – 27th March 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 08.04.2019. the institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice on 26.04.2019.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 377th meeting held on 03rd – 04th July, 2019 March 2019 considered the matter and decided to Withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Withdrawal order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO7944 /B.Ed/AP/2019/106760-6765 dated 10.07.2019 was issued to the institution.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order dated 18.02.2020 appeal remand back the Order appealed against.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 385th meeting held on 03rd March 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause

Notice was issued to the institution on 13.03.2020. The institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice on 10.08.2021.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th meeting held during 13th – 14th December 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 10.08.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. The institution has not submitted latest Staff list duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
The institution did not submit details of administrative and professional staff as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014 for B.Ed. course.
3. The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014
4. The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
5. The institution has submitted notarized photocopy of Certificate in which diverted area not mentioned in reply of LUC/CLU.
6. The institution has submitted notarized photocopy of Building Plan in Multipurpose not mentioned. Moreover, the Building plan does not show the detail of separate toilet facilities for male & female students for staff, and for PWD as per NCTE Regulation 2014 and Appendix 4
7. The institution has submitted notarized photocopy of Building Plan not approved by competent authority.
8. The institution has submitted original FDR Rs.3 Lakhs & Rs. 5Lakhs against the requirement of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years along with a copy of the FDRs as per NCTE Regulation 2014. Further, the institution has not submitted form 'A' in original towards proof of joint FDRs with the institution and Regional Director, SRC.

*Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Ravoof & Vazir Khans Memorial College of Education, S.No.278/3, P.No.67-83, chapuram Panchayat, Srikakulam District, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** with effect from the academic session i.e. 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."*

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of ***Ravoof & Vazir Khans Memorial College of Education, S.No.278/3, P.No.67-83, chapuram Panchayat, Srikakulam District, Andhra Pradesh*** for conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) for B.Ed. course with effect from the academic session i.e. 2022-2023 onwards.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
