Withdrawal Order

Whereas, the institution **JSS Institute of Education, Huvinahadagali, Bellary District, Karnataka-583219** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2004-2005/8983 dt. 01.12.2004 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

And Whereas, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 17.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

And Whereas, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

And Whereas, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

And Whereas, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 10.10.2019.

And Whereas, the matter was placed before in 314th meeting of SRC held on 27th & 28th May 2016 and decided to be directed for inspection and letter was sent to the institution on dt. 13.06.2016, but the inspection was not conducted.

And Whereas, the institution submitted inspection fee on Rs. 1,50,000/- on dt. 09.08.2016. and a letter dt. 19.11.2016 has been received from the institution on dt. 21.11.2016.

And Whereas, the matter was placed in SRC in its 324th meeting held on 07 & 08th December 2016, and issue a letter to institution on dt. 16.01.2016.

And Whereas, the institution has submitted a document for one unit on dt. 29.12.2016

And Whereas, the SRC in its 344th meeting held on 17th and 18th August 2017 considered the reply and decided to issued a Show Cause Notice.

As per directed a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 09.09.2017.

And Whereas, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 07.08.2020.

Thereafter, SRC in its meeting held on 31st October & 01st November 2019 consider the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution who has not submit reply against Show Cause Notice.

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And Whereas, as per directed a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 10.09.2020.

And Whereas, it is pertinent to mention here that the institution has not submitted document Final Show Cause Notice till dated.

And Whereas, the SRC in its 390th meeting held on dt. 28th October 2020 and considered the matter as under: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 10.09.2020.

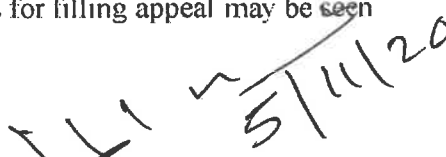
1. The institution has failed in submission of written representation along with all required documents in response to Final Show Cause Notice.

And Whereas, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **JSS Institute of Education, Huvinahadagali, Bellary District, Karnataka-583219** for conducting **B.Ed** courses w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act. 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
