CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14 (3) (a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Moghal College of Education, Hyderabad District, Andhra Pradesh run by Moghal Educational Society, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed. & B.Ed-AI programme as per following details:-**

- (i) Vide Order No. F. No. AP/NEW/B.Ed/177/SRO/NCTE/2002-2003/6135 dated 28.02.2003 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2002-2003.
- (ii) Vide order F. No. SRO/NCTE/B.Ed-AI/2007-2008/14306 dated 07.11.2007 for conducting B.Ed-AI Programme of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 22.01.2015 for its willingness and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution on 27.04.2015 for conducting B.Ed. and B.Ed-AI of two years duration with an annual intake of 200 for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-16 was issued instead of two units.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Corrigendum No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS07232/B.Ed.-AI/AP/2015/70542 dated 22.07.2015 for granting recognition to **Moghal College of Education, D. no. 8-5-2/18, Bandlaguda, Near Chandrayanagutta, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh - 500005** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 200 for (four basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 was issued.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st Nov 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the requisite documents/VT report accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, a First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 19.11.2019. The institution has submitted reply of First Show Cause Notice on 16.12.2019.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 400th meeting held on 13th – 14th July 2021 has considered the matter and decided to issue a Final Show Cause. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause was issued to the institution on 03.08.2021. The institution has submitted a reply to the Final Show Cause Notice on 02.09.2021.

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6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 409th meeting held on 29th – 30th March 2022 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a withdrawal order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS00342 & APS07232/B.Ed. & B.Ed-AI/TS/2022/131584-131588 was issued to the institution on 20.04.2022.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed W.P. (C) No.13889/2022 In pursuant to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi order dated 26.09.2022 the institution is entitled to participate in the counselling for the academic session 2022-2023 vide order dated 19.10.2022.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-155/E-257533/2022 Appeal/7th Meeting, 2022 Appeal No.APPLSRC202214398 dated 19.10.2022 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution vide dated 26.10.2022 has submitted a reply to the Appeal Remand Back Case.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 415th meeting held on 03rd & 04th November 2022 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made were made: -

*The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the **continuation order** be issued to the Institution **Moghal College of Education, Survey No. 169, Beside Masjid e Salaheen, Maheshwari Oil Mill, Bandlaguda Khalsa, Village Charminar Mandal, R.R District-500005, Telangana for B.Ed. programme, 4 basic units of 50 students each.**"*

10. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Moghal College of Education, Survey No. 169, Beside Masjid e Salaheen, Maheshwari Oil Mill, Bandlaguda Khalsa, Village Charminar Mandal, R.R District-500005, Telangana** run by **Moghal Educational Society, Hyderabad, Telangana** for continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. Programme** for two years duration (**4 basic units**) of **50 students each** subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.



IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

11. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

12. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

13. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

15. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

16. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.



If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

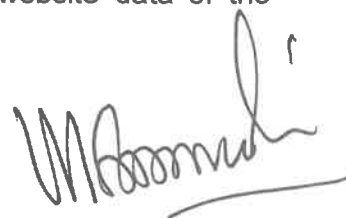
