WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **King College of Education, N.Pudupatti Post, Nallur-637020, Namakkal District, TamilNadu** run by **Sheela Christian Charitable Trust, Namakkal District, TamilNadu** vide SRC (NCTE) Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/8137 dated 05.10.2006 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic year 2006-2007.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 19.01.2015 and the Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16 on 18.03.2015.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 388th Meeting held on 14th & 15th September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the requisite documents/VT Report accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 08.06.2021. The management of the institution had not submitted a reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 411th meeting held on 23rd – 24th May 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue a Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 04.06.2022. The management of the institution has not submitted the reply of Final Show Cause Notice till the date.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 415th Meeting of SRC held on 03rd – 04th November 2022 considered the matter for non-submission of reply to Final Show Cause Notice and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

- (i) ***The institution failed to submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice dated 04.06.2022.***
- (ii) ***The Committee noted that the institution has not filled Performance Appraisal Report (PAR)***

Hence the recognition granted to King College of Education, N.Pudupatti Post, Nallur-637020, Namakkal District, TamilNadu for B.Ed. course is withdrawn

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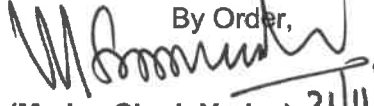
under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the end of next academic session i.e. 2023-2024. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn”.

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **King College of Education, N.Pudupatti Post, Nallur-637020, Namakkal District, TamilNadu** for conducting **B.Ed. Programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (two basic units)** with effect from the end of next academic session i.e., 2023-2024.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
