WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Nadar MahajanSangam S. Vellaichamy Nadar College of Education, Theni Main Road, Nagamalai, Madurai District-625019, TamilNadu** run by **Nadar Mahajana Sangam S. Vellai Chamy Nadar Kalloori, Madurai District, TamilNadu** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/10524 dt. 03.02.2007 for **B.Ed.** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 11.03.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students for two basic units** from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th – 15th September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 08.06.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 19.06.2021.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 400th Meeting of SRC held on 13th & 14th July, 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 02.08.2021. The institution has submitted reply receive on 12.08.2021.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th Meeting held on 13th & 14th December, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

“The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply on 31.07.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. The institution was informed about the deficiency in faculty that 2 lecturers do not have NET / Ph.D. and % of marks in PG Degree of Mr. V. Mohanraj is less than 55%. The institution with its reply submitted a copy of letter dt. 29.07.2021 alongwith proforma issued and signed by the Registrar, TTEU regarding approval of 2 faculty. The institution did not submit the approval letter in respect of third faculty namely Mr. Mariselvam.

2. The institution did not submit latest and consolidated approval of faculty issued by the affiliating University.
3. The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
4. The institution submitted a copy of Encumbrance Certificate wherein the nature of land is shown as "Housing" and "Agricultural" which is not permissible under rules.
5. The institution submitted a copy of building plan but the same is not legible. Further, the discrepancy regarding area of multipurpose hall is not removed.
6. In the earlier submitted BCC only first floor with constructed area of 15995 sq. ft. was shown. The latest BCC Submitted by the institution shows the ground, first and second floor with constructed area of 256195 sq. ft. Further, the Land Continuity Certificate submitted by the institution shows the total built up area of building as 15995 sq. ft. The institution submitted contradictory documents regarding built up area.
7. The institution did not submit an Affidavit on Rs. 100/- stamp paper regarding land details.
8. The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Nadar MahajanSangam S. Vellaichamy Nadar College of Education, Theni Main Road, Nagamalai, Madurai District-625019, TamilNadu** for conducting **B.Ed.** programme with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Nadar MahajanSangam S. Vellaichamy Nadar College of Education, Theni Main Road, Nagamalai, Madurai District-625019, TamilNadu** run by **Nadar Mahajana Sangam S. Vellai Chamy Nadar Kalloori, Madurai District, TamilNadu** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic units)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
