### TO BE PUBLISHED IN GAZETTE OF INDIA PART III SECTION 4 WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, Al-Meezan Educational Association's B.Ed. College, Highlands, Anandnagar Road, Old Hubli, Dharwad District, Karnataka-580024 vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/4826 dt. 21.12.2005 for conducting secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 30.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units from the academic session 2015-16.
- 4. **AND WHEREAS,** the inspection was conducted on 26.12.2016 and VT report was received on 29.12.2016. The SRC in its 381<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> October & 01<sup>st</sup> November, 2019 Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institution which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 06.11.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the Show Cause Notice.
- 5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 29.09.2020. The institution has submitted reply on 02.11.2020.
- 6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 405<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply on 02.11.2020. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

- The institution submitted a proforma of 15 faculty only for the academic session 2018-19. The institution did not submit latest approval of faculty duly signed and approved by the affiliating University. Further, the faculty strength is not enough to run B.Ed. course (2 units) as required under Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 2. The building plan submitted by the institution do not show the availability of Multipurpose Hall.
- The institution did not submit prescribed format of LUC and B₲€

4. The institution did not submit form 'A' issued by the bank regarding maintenance of FDRs towards Endowment and Reserve Funds as required under NCTE Regulations, 2014.

5. The institution did not submit details of administrative and professional staff as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014 for B.Ed.

course.

6. The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

7. The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

8. The institution did not submit registration, bye-laws etc. related to the managing society / trust.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Al-Meezan Educational Association's B.Ed. College, Highlands, Anandnagar Road, Old Hubli, Dharwad District, Karnataka-580024 for conducting B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

- 7. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Al-Meezan Educational Association's B.Ed. College, Highlands, Anandnagar Road, Old Hubli, Dharwad District, Karnataka-580024 run by Al-Meezan Educational Association, Hubli, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 basic units) with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.
- **8.** Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <a href="www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
