WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **K.M.M. College of Education, Ramireddipalli, Narasingapuram, Chandragiri Mandal, Tirupathi-517102, Andhra Pradesh** run by **K.M.M. Social and Educational Development Society, Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order No F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2006-2007/6144 dated 09.07.2007 for conducting Secondary **B.Ed. Course** of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution had submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 27.04.2015 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 363rd meeting held on 17th to 19th September 2018 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 16.10.2018. The institution vide letter dated 24.10.2018 submitted reply of Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 395th meeting held on 25th - 26th February 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.03.2021. The institution has submitted the reply on 09.4.2021.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 400th Meeting held on 13th & 14th July, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide dated 01.04.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. *The institution has submitted photocopy of sale deed and not submitted Certified Land Documents.*
2. *The institution has submitted photocopy of Land Use Certificate without self-attested/Notarized.*
3. *The institution has submitted photocopy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate without self-attested/Notarized.*
4. *The institution has submitted photocopy of Building Plan in which the built-up area and multipurpose hall are not readable.*

5. The institution has not submitted the latest approved faculty detail. Moreover, the submitted faculty detail, they have not appointed Lecturer for Perspective of Education as per NCTE Regulation, 2014.
6. The institution has submitted photocopy of Form 'A' and the FDRs for Rs. 5.00 lakhs issued by Branch Manager of Andhra Bank in which the FDRs are not readable.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **K.M.M. College of Education, Ramireddipalli, Narasingapuram, Chandragiri Mandal, Tirupathi-517102, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed.** programme with effect from the academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

6. **NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **K.M.M. College of Education, Ramireddipalli, Narasingapuram, Chandragiri Mandal, Tirupathi-517102, Andhra Pradesh** run by **K.M.M. Social and Educational Development Society, Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh** for **B.Ed.** Programme with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
