WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, B.S.S. B.Ed. Training College, Alathur Post, Palakkad District, Pin - 678541, Kerala vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.KL/SEC/N/136/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/757 dated 23.02.2005 for conducting Secondary course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 30.01.2015.
- AND WHEREAS, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the 3. institution on 13.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- AND WHEREAS, a photocopy of letter No.22569/CDC-A2/2014/CU dated 16.11.2015 4. was received from University of Calicut approved by the Deputy Registrar regarding Redistribution of seats in optional subjects with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic year 2015-16 onwards. The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 343<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on August 1-2, 2017, and the Committee decided to reduce the intake strength from 2 to 1 unit. Accordingly, an order for reduction of strength from 2 units to 1 unit issued to the institution vide F.No.SRO/NCTE/APSO0714/B.Ed./KL/2017-18/94879 on 13.09.2017.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, First Show Cause Notice issued on 16.07.2019 to the reply within 30 days. The institution submitted its reply on 29.08.2019.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 383rd meeting held on January 7-9, 2020 and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 20.01,2020. The institution submitted its reply on 29.01.2020 & 04.02.2020.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 387th meeting held on August 24-25, 2020 and the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution. Accordingly, the Withdrawal Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS00714/B.Ed./{KL}/2020/117670-676 dated 07.09.2020 was issued to the institution.

8. AND WHEREAS, the institution has filed W.P. (C) 18243 of 2020 (E) in the High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam against withdrawal order dt. 07.09.2020. The Hon'ble High Court of Kerala passed an order dt. September 25, 2020. The operative part is as under: -

"...the petitioner institution in the respective writ petitions shall submit the list of faculties in the prescribed format, before the affiliating University, within one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgement, if not already submitted. The affiliating University shall permit admission for B.Ed. course in the petitioner institutions, for the academic session year 2020-2021, only if the faculties are having the requisite qualification as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014. The faculties appointed after 09.06.2017 shall have the requisite qualification as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended by the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) (Amendment) Regulation, 2017."

- 9. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 389<sup>th</sup> meeting held on October 12 & 14, 2020 and the Committee decided to issue a letter to the institution to submit the list of faculty members (in prescribed format) duly approved by the affiliating body within one week along with the other documents mentioned under withdrawal order of concerned institution. Accordingly, the letter was issued to the institution on 16.10.2020. In response, reply received through email dated 14.10.2020 and reply was received on 20.10.2020.
- 10. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 391st meeting held on November 03, 2020 and the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, the Withdrawal Order No.F.SRO/NCTE/APS00714/B.Ed./391ST/{KL}/2020 dated 09.11.2020 issued to the institution. Thereafter, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-290/E-17217/2020 Appeal/4th Mtg.2021/21st January,2021/97553 dt. 15.02.2021 remands back the case to SRC for revisiting the matter after the appellant submits to SRC within 15 days of the issue of appeal order a legible copy of building plan duly approved by Municipal Authority. The institution did not submit any reply till date.
- 11. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 397<sup>th</sup> meeting held on March 25-26, 2021 and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to institution on 08.04.2021. Accordingly, the institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 07.05.2021 received on 27.05.2021.
- 12. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 399<sup>th</sup> meeting held on June 15-16, 2021 and the Committee decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee on perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution B.S.S. B.Ed. Training College, Survey No. 447/4,5,9 Alathur Village, Palakkad District-678541, Kerala for B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."

- 13. NOW THEREFORE, the SRC decided to permit the institution i.e., B.S.S. B.Ed. Training College, Survey No. 447/4,5,9 Alathur Village, Palakkad District-678541, Kerala run by Brahmananda Swami Sivayogi Educational Society, Sidhasramam, P.O. Alathur, Palghat Dt., Kerala, Pin 678541 for continuation of recognition for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:
  - 1. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.

II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in

the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014

IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

- 14. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
- 15. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 16. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme (s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:

b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.

c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:

d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.:

e. Fee charged from students;

f. Available infrastructural facilities;

g. Facilities added during the last quarter;

h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;

i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.

j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.

- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and 17. display up-to-date information on its official website.
- The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website. 18.
- The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website. If the 19. institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
