WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **L.V.R. Naidu College of Education, Veeraraghavapuram, Thiruvallangadu, Thiruthani Taluk, Thiruvallur, Tamilnadu-631210** run by **Besent Educational & Cultural Society, Thiruvallur District, Tamilnadu** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2008/6051 dt. 22.09.2008 for Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 16.02.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 05.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issue to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on **28.03.2019**. The institution did not submit reply to the Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its meeting 380th Meeting held on 18th – 19th September, 2019 the Sub-Committee noted that institutions have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply has been submitted. The Sub-Committee decided to issue SCN/FSCN. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.11.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 404th Meeting held on 16th & 17th November, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice on 26.09.2019. The institution failed to submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN).

*Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition granted to L.V.R. Naidu College of Education, Veeraraghavapuram, Thiruvallangadu, Thiruthani Taluk, Thiruvallur-631210, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.***

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **L.V.R. Naidu College of Education, Veeraraghavapuram, Thiruvallangadu, Thiruthani Taluk, Thiruvallur-631210, Tamilnadu** run by **Besent Educational & Cultural Society, Thiruvallur District, Tamilnadu** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic units)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
