CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14 of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Lenora College of Education, Rampachodavaram Revenue Division, East Godavari District-533288, Andhra Pradesh** vide order no. F.AP/NEW/B.Ed./105/SO/NCTE/2003-04/419 dt.16.12.2003 for conducting B.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 100 students for academic session 2003-2004.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 19.01.2015. A revised provisional recognition order was issued on 30.05.2015 to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 342nd meeting held on 5th – 6th July, 2017 considered the request for reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit. Accordingly, an order dated 21.07.2017 for reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit was issued as per the decision of SRC.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the Status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22nd Oct. 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institution have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply has been submitted. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.10.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th Meeting held on 13th & 14th December, 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 31.12.2021. The institution has submitted a reply on 02.01.2022.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 408th meeting held on 02nd March, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC withdrawal order no. F.SRC/NCTE/APS00099/B.Ed/AP/2022/130757-130761 dated 14.03.2022 was issued to the institution.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi bearing W.P (C) No.13973/2022 titled as Lenora Collage of Education versus National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. Whereby the Hon'ble High Court in its order dated 27.09.2022 has directed that: -



"The NCTE is directed to reflect the status of the Petitioner as a recognized institution for the year 2022-23 on its website. The NCTE is also directed to communicate the same to the Petitioner's affiliating university and the concerned State Government within one week from today.

The Appellate Authority of the NCTE may also endeavour to dispose of the Petitioner's appeal as expeditiously as possible and will in any event do so not later than three months from today."

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 415th meeting held on 03rd – 04th November, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 17.11.2022.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order dated 14.03.2022 of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order no. F.No.89-117/E-253561/2022/Appeal/8th Meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202214406 dated 16.11.2022 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution vide letter dated 22.11.2022 submitted reply to the appeal remand back order.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 418th Meeting held on 16th December, 2022 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

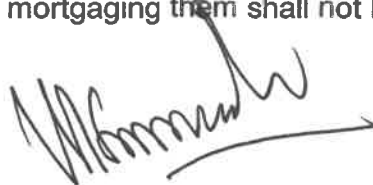
"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Lenora College of Education, Survey No. 120/2A, Ward No. 3, Yerramreddy Nagar, Rampachodavaram Panchayat, East Godavari District – 533288, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students.

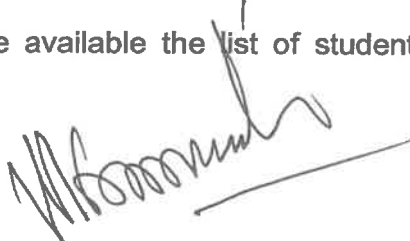
The Committee further decided that the above said decision will be subject to the outcome of writ petition pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in respect of Performance Appraisal Report (PAR)."

11. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., Lenora College of Education, Survey No. 120/2A, Ward No. 3, Yerramreddy Nagar, Rampachodavaram Panchayat, East Godavari District – 533288, Andhra Pradesh for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 1 basic unit of 50 students subject to the outcome of writ petition pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in respect of Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) and fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.



- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
12. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
13. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
14. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
15. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
16. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

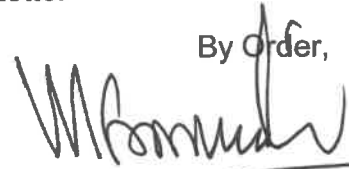


17. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
