WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Pallavi College of Education, Nancherla Gate, Gandeedmandal, Ranga Reddy District, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Pallavi Educational Society, Ranga Reddy District, Andhra Pradesh** vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/668 dt. 12.04.2007 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 23.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students** for **two basic units** from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 369th Meeting held on 28.01.2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted requisite documents/VT report accompanied with requisite documents in responds to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 28.02.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 08.04.2019

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st Meeting held on 31st October & 01st November 2019 the matter was considered and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 19.11.2019. The institution has not submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 410th Meeting held on 25th & 26th April, 2022 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply on 08.04.2019. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. *The institution failed to submit certified copy of land documents issued by concerned Tehsildar /Revenue Officer. (If the same are in Regional Language the institution is also required to submit notarized copy of English version of land documents).*
2. *The building plan submitted by the institution is not approved by the competent authority.*
3. *The institution did not submit form 'A' issued by the concerned bank regarding maintenance of FDRs towards Endowment and Reserve Fund. The institution is only submitted photocopy of FDRs of Rs. 5+3 Lakhs (Rs. 8 Lakhs) which was matured on 29.09.2020.*
4. *The institution submitted approval of 7 faculty obtained from the University in the years 2015. The institution did not submit latest approval of faculty issued by the*

University. Further, the faculty strength is not enough for B.Ed. course as stipulated under Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

5. The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
6. The institution did not submit an Affidavit on Rs. 100/- stamp paper regarding land details.

Hence the recognition granted to **Pallavi College of Education, Survey no. 450 & 452, Nancherla Gate, Mandal Gandeed, R.R. District, Andhra Pradesh – 509337** for B.Ed. course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session i.e., **2022-2023**. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counselling / making admissions from the next academic session i.e., **2022-2023**.”

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Pallavi College of Education, Survey no. 450 & 452, Nancherla Gate, Mandal Gandeed, R.R. District, Telangana – 509337** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic units)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards. Further, on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate counselling from the academic session i.e., **2022-2023** and the institution is also not permitted to take any fresh admission of students from the academic session **2022-2023**.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
