WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Saleem Minority Educational Service Society, Plot No. 7-116, Near Govt Hospital, Brahanakotkur Village and Post Office, Nandikotkur Taluka, Kurnool District – 518432, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE in the name of Haji Kareem College of Education, Khasra No. 07, Near Govt. Hospital, Plot No. 7.116, Brahmanakotkur Village, Nandikotkur Taluka, Kurnool District – 518432, Andhra Pradesh for seeking grant of recognition for conducting B.Ed Course of one year duration on 24.10.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the file was under process and in the meanwhile, in view of the recommendations of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh vide letter dated 07.01.2009 not to further recognize/permit the institutions for conducting B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit course(s), to this effect that application for B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit courses from the States of Andhra Pradesh will not be considered for the academic session 2009-2010 and all such applications shall be returned along with processing fees and documents.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 169th meeting held on 12-13th January, 2009 having considered the letter dated 7.1.2009 of State Government of Andhra Pradesh and decided to give effect to the decision of above decision of State Government of Andhra Pradesh as such, with immediate effect.

AND WHEREAS, a letter dated 07.02.2009 forwarded by Principal Secretary of Education requesting not to accord further recognition/permission to the new colleges/private B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit in the state of Andhra Pradesh as the above colleges are exceeding in numbers than required.

AND WHEREAS, a letter dated 17.03.2009 has been received from NCTE Hqrs informing that the "The recommendations of the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh not to grant recognition/permission in respect of other courses like B.Ed, D.Ed and Physical Education courses have further been considered in NCTE and it has been decided that no further recognition/Permission to any institution in the state of Andhra Pradesh be considered by SRC for the academic session 2009-10 for B.Ed, D.Ed and physical Education Courses also".

AND WHEREAS, the State Government vide its letter dated 20.03.2009 informed that it has been decided not to recommend the name of this institution.

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AND WHEREAS, the letters dated 07.01.2009, 07.02.2009, 17.03.2009 and 20.03.2009 were considered by SRC in its 172nd meeting held on 25th-26th March 2009 and SRC decided to accept the recommendation of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, not to grant recognition to any of the Teacher Training Institutions in the state of Andhra Pradesh for the year 2009-10 and decided to close the applications.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC the application was closed on 28.04.2009 and processing fee of Rs.40000/- was returned.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has approached to Hon'ble High court of Andhra Pradesh without making appeal to appellate authority under section 18 of NCTE Act

AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court has passed an order on 06.05.2010 vide W.P.No.11078 of 2010 to consider the application of the petitioner without making reference to the recommendation of State Government Policy dated 07.01.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the Committee considered the matter in its 193rd Meeting held on 21-22 June 2010 and decided to process the application.

AND WHEREAS, the Committee considered the matter in its 195th Meeting held on 17-18 August 2010 and decided to call for clarification from the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 199th meeting held on 22nd -23rd December, 2010 considered the matter and all relevant documents and decided to cause inspection to examine whether the institution fulfils all the requirements as per the norms, for the proposed programme; subject to the condition that the deficiencies, if any, were duly rectified by the institution, as per the norms.

Accordingly inspection of the institution was carried out on VTR dated 07.02.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 202nd Meeting held on 14th-15th, 2011 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to issue Show Cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution for seeking clarification on 06.04.2011 for the following:

- 1) As per the observation from the VCD, It is clear that no multipurpose hall is existing in the building where the classes are proposed to be conducted.
- 2) The building where the classes are conducted is a residential building but building completion certificate is issued by the PWD is for Educational institution.
- 3) The existing laboratory rooms and class rooms are not spacious to accommodate the students.
- 4) A certificate from the affiliating University / Body stating that no other programmes is being run in the same building/premises in which B.Ed programme is being proposed, should be submitted.

AND WHEREAS, the institution had submitted its written representation on 21.04.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the Committee in its 204th Meeting of SRC held on 27th - 28th April 2011 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Final Show cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act for the following:

- 1) As per VCD, the present course is being conducted in a Residential Building.
- 2) The existing laboratory rooms and class rooms are not spacious to accommodate the students.

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AND WHEREAS, as per direction of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the applicant institution on 01.06.2011. In response to this office notice dated 01.06.2011 the institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 14.06.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the Committee in its 208th Meeting of SRC held on 13th – 14th July considered the reply of the institution dated 01.06.2011, and decided to issue letter of intent prior to grant of recognition under clause 7(9) of the NCTE regulation, for grant of recognition to B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100(One hundred only)(one unit) for the academic year 2011-12 subject to the appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee (within 10 days) as per the Norms of NCTE/State Government/Affiliating University and be given effect before the commencement of the academic session.

AND WHEREAS, a letter of intent was issued to the institution on 20.07.2011. The institution submitted in its reply on 27.07.2011. SRC considered the reply submitted by the institution in its 209th Meeting held on 31st July 2011 and decided that, Formal Recognition be granted to B.Ed., course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred only) students, subject to the rectification of deficiency in staff list, if any..

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Haji Kareem College of Education, Khasra No. 07, Near Govt, Hospital, Plot No. 7.116, Brahmanakotkur Village, Nandikotkur Taluka, Kurnool District – 518432, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred) students from the academic session 2011-2012 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

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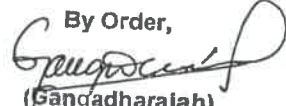
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The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
