WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Sri Radhakrishna College of Education, Palakonda Revenue Division, Vaddadivari Street, Palakonda Srikakulam Dt. Andhra Pradesh run by Sri Radha Krishna Educational Society, Palakonda, Palakonda Mandalam, Srikakulam District, Andhra Pradesh. The SRC vide order F.AP/NEW/B.Ed/196/SRO/NCTE/2002-2003/6153 dt.26.03.2003 for conducting (B.Ed.) course of two-year duration from the academic session 2002-03 with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 02.04.2015. A Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 26.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units) from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter was addressed to the institution regarding shifting to permanent premises on 25.05.2009. On 23.06.2009 the institution had submitted certain documents pertaining to shifting of premises to permanent building. There is no correspondence available regarding proposal of shifting of premises to permanent building.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 273rd meeting held during 30th September & 1st October, 2014 considered the matter, letter dated 23.06.2009 from the institution decided and advised Southern Regional Office to:

1. Collect updated information and documents.

2. Process after notification of new regulations,

5. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter seeking consent on the willingness of the institution for considering their application as per Regulations 2014 was sent to the institution on 19.12.2014. In response to this office letter dated 19.12.2014, the institution has submitted a reply on 24.12.2014, along with relevant documents.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 278th Meeting held on 25th January, 2015 the committee considered the matter and it was decided to **affidavit not received, Process if affidavit is received.**

7. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter was issued to the institution on 18.02.2015. The institution has submitted willingness affidavit as per regulations 2014 on 10.03.2015 which was placed before SRC in its 284th Meeting held on 09th-10th April, 2015 considered the matter and it was decided to **1. Issue RPRO with the standard the position 2. Process for causing inspection after.**

8. **AND WHEREAS**, a revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 26.05.2015 with the condition that the institution has not shifted to its own premises as stipulated in its formal recognition order dated 26.03.2003.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of the SRC, the documents was processed and placed before the SRC in its 317th meeting held on 28th – 30th July, 2016. The Committee considered the matter and decided as under:

1. Title deed is there shows land area is adequate.
 2. LUC not given.
 3. EC is in order.
 4. BP is in order. But, it shows that built-up area is adequate for only one unit of B.Ed.
 5. BCC not given.
 6. Original FDRs not given.
 7. Faculty list – not given.
 8. Fee – only 50,000/- paid.
 - 9.1. Collect balance of fee and cause Inspection.
 - 9.2. Ask VT to collect all relevant documents.
 - 9.3. Ask VT to assess adequacy of facilities for B.Ed (2 units).
- The institution has submitted representation on 24.01.2017.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 330st meeting held on 12th & 13th February, 2017 considered the matter and decided:-

1. They want to reduce from 2 units to 1 unit. Built up area is bound to be adequate.
2. There is, therefore, no need of inspection.
3. Permit reduction from 2 units to 1 unit.
4. Obtain for verification, LUC, BCC, FDRs and latest Faculty List.

Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 04.03.2017.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 342nd meeting held on 5-6 July, 2017 considered the matter and decided to issue reduction order from 2 units to 1 unit. An order for reduction of strength from 2 units to 1 unit issued on 21.07.2017.

12. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 343rd meeting held on 1-2 August, 2017 considered the matter and decided as under:-

1. These are RPRO cases. In view of the latest instructions, no inspection is required in there.
2. But, there also involve 'shifting'. Therefore, VT Inspection will require.
3. The SRO's required is noted and permission is given for organizing VT Inspection in case in these cases.

A Visiting team members Selection through online on 08.09.2017.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such

institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 01.03.2019. The institution has submitted its reply on 18.03.2019.

14. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st, Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Final SCN u/s 17 of the NCTE Act issued to the institution to submit its representation/reply to the observation noted by the Regional Committee. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 13.11.2019. The institution submitted its reply to the FSCN vide letter dated 26.12.2019 & 17.02.2020.

15. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on December 15-16, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

1. The management has not shifted its institution to its own permanent building which is in **violation of the NCTE Regulations, 2002, 3(C)**.

In addition to the above, the Committee also noted the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies: -

1. *The institution has not submitted certified copy of land documents issued by concerned Tehsildar /Revenue Officer. (If the same are in Regional Language the institution is also required to submit notarized copy of English version of land documents).*
2. *The institution has submitted photocopy of Land Use Conversion Certificate. Wherein the following discrepancies found: -*
 - (i) *Survey No. not mentioned.*
 - (ii) *Purpose of LUC is mentioned agricultural Land from the date of vide registration CS.1046/2001 date 16.05.2001.*
3. *The institution has not submitted an attested/notarized copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.*
 - (i) *The institution has submitted photocopy of Building Plan but the same was not approved by the competent authority. As per building plan built-up area not sufficient for B.Ed. 1unit. Multipurpose hall not mentioned in Building Plan.*
4. *The institution has submitted photocopy of Site Plan but not approved by competent authority.*
5. *The institution has submitted photocopy of Building Completion Certificate but survey No and built-up area not mentioned.*

6. The institution has not submitted Letter regarding approval of faculty issued by the affiliating body submitted.
 - (i) The institution has not appointed the faculty of Performing Arts, Health & Physical Education and Fine Arts.
7. The institution has submitted copy of FDRs Rs.3Lakhs and 5Lakhs.
 - (i) FDR No.38863582122 Rs.3 Lakhs is individual name.
 - (ii) FDR No.34236838930 Rs.5 Lakhs is Matured on 25.09.2019.
 - (iii) The **institution** is has not submitted the "Form A" issued by the respective Bank Manger towards creation of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totaling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years along with a copy of the FDRs.
8. Domain name of the website being run by the institution not submitted.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Sri Radhakrishna College of Education, Palakonda Revenue Division, Vaddadivari Street, Palakonda Srikakulam Dt. Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed** course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

16. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Sri Radhakrishna College of Education, Palakonda Revenue Division, Vaddadivari Street, Palakonda Srikakulam Dt. Andhra Pradesh** run by **Sri Radha Krishna Educational Society, Palakonda, Palakonda Mandalam, Srikakulam District, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students w.e.f. the next academic session.

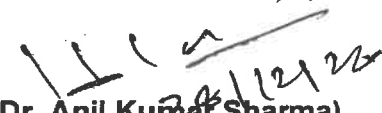
17. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

18. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website

www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
