WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Kalikamba College of Education, Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh run by Kalikamba Educational Society, Pradesh. The SRC Andhra District, F.AP/NEW/B.ED./260/sro/ncte/2002-2003/6128 dt.03.03.2003 for conducting (B.Ed.) course of two-year duration from the academic session 2002-03 with an annual intake of 100 students.

- AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 19.02.2015. A Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 12.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 315th meeting held on 17th & 18th June 2016 and the Committee decided as under: -
 - They have contested the Shifting Condition saying that the Regulations permit them operate on leased land until the lease period runs out. Also, they have constructed a permanent structure. Their contention is accepted. The shifting condition is removed.

EC and LUC are in order. ii.

BP is given. According to it, built-up area is adequate for B.Ed. (1 unit) iii.

BCC is not given. iv.

Original FDRs, Faculty List and Processing fee are not given. ٧.

Collect fee and cause inspection. vi.

Ask VT to collect all relevant documents and check particularly adequacy of built-up vii. area for B.Ed. (2 units) for the 2014 pattern.

Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 12.07.2016 regarding Shifting Condition.

- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 321st meeting held on 28th & 30th September 2016 and the Committee decided that we should use this opportunity to verify the basic facts with respect to documents in all such RPRO cases many of which relate to very old FRs issued by us. R.D. may collect - Land deeds; LUC; EC; BP; BCC; FDRs; AND Faculty Lists and get them processed by office so that we can critically scrutinize the facts and take appropriate decisions about issue of new FRs.
- AND WHEREAS, The SRC in its meeting held on 22nd Oct 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents in response to RPRO issued by the SRC. Further the Committee also suggested on

receiving the reply to the SCN, the SRO may scrutinize the documents and still if there are some deficiency/lapses, the RD is authorized to issue First SCN and then place the cases before the SRC for its perusal and decision. Accordingly, a First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on **24.10.2019**. The institution has not submitted any reply in response to the First Show Cause Notice till date.

- 6. AND WHEREAS, a letter dated 12.12.2019 was received from the institution regarding request for issue of Regular Recognition Order. A letter was issued to the institution on 31.01.2020 for recognition status and the recognition will be continue.
- 7. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on December 15-16, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

1. The management has not shifted its institution to its own permanent building which is in violation of the NCTE Regulations, 2002, 3(C).

2. The institution has also not responded to the Show Cause Notice issued on 24.10.2019.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Kalikamba College of Education, Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

- 8. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Kalikamba College of Education, Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh run by Kalikamba Educational Society, Prakasan District, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students w.e.f. the next academic session.
- 9. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

10. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
