WHEREAS, recognition u/s14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, J.Beera College of Education, Seetaramapuram Village, Narasapuram Mandal, West Godavari Andhra Pradesh vide order no.F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2007-2008/11443 dt.17.09.2007 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 17.01.2015. A revised provisional recognition order was issued on 06.05.2015 to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> Oct., 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institutions have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply been submitted. The Sub-Committee decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.10.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the First Show Cause Notice.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause was issued to the institution on 02.03.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 26.03.2021.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its  $409^{th}$  Meeting of SRC held on  $29^{th}-30^{th}$  March 2022 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply received on 26.03.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

- 1. The institution has submitted list of faculty but the following deficiency observed:-
  - (i) Principal does not possesP.hd.
  - (ii) Three lecture does not possesP.hd./Net. as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 (amended vide notification dt. 09.06.2017).

- (iii) The institution did not submit the bank statement showing disbursement of salary to faculty through bank account as stipulated under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 2. The institution has not submitted "Form A" issued by the respective Bank Manger towards creation of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years along with a copy of the FDRs.

Hence the recognition granted to J.Beera College of Education, Seetaramapuram Village, Narasapuram Mandal, West Godavari, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed. course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session i.e. 2022-2023. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counseling / making admissions from the next academic session i.e., 2022-2023".

- 6. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition J.Beera College of Education, Seetaramapuram Village, Narasapuram Mandal, West Godavari, Andhra Pradesh run by Mission of Hope, East Godavari, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards. Further, on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to apply for counselling from the academic session i.e. 2022-2023 and the institution is also not permitted to take any fresh admission of students from the academic session 2022-2023.
- 7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website

www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
