WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Penubala College of Education, Rly, Kodur – 516101, Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh run by Bapuji Youth Association, 10/446, R.S. Kodur – 516101, Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh. The SRC vide order F.AP/NEW/B.Ed/298/SRO/NCTE/2003-2004/9999 dt.18.11.2003 for conducting (B.Ed.) course of two-year duration from the academic session 2003-04 with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. AND WHEREAS, as per the MIS records on 21.01.2015 affidavit received by this office as per regulation 2014. But not available in the file. A Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 25.02.2016 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units) from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on 30.04.2019. The institution has not submitted any reply to Show Cause Notice till date.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on December 15-16, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

1. The management has not shifted its institution to its own permanent building which is in violation of the NCTE Regulations, 2002, 3(C).
2. The institution has also not responded to the Show Cause Notice issued on 30.04.2019.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Penubala College of Education, Rly, Kodur – 516101, Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

5. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Penubala College of Education, Rly, Kodur – 516101, Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Bapuji Youth Association, 10/446, R.S. Kodur – 516101, Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students w.e.f. the next academic session.

6. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
