WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Mother Teresa College of Education, 669, Raigir Village, Bhongir Mandal, Nalgonda District - 508006, Andhra Pradesh run by Mother Theresa Educational Society, Raigir Village, Nalgonda District - 508006, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO2657/B.Ed/2004-2005/1090 dt 08.03.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt. 20.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, a revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 11.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted its written representation on 31.10.2015 along with relevant documents. The SRC in its 317th meeting held on 28th & 30 July, 2016 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 10.08.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st, Nov. 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Final SCN u/s 17 of the NCTE Act issued to the institution to submit its representation/reply to the observation noted by the Regional Committee. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 21.11.2019.The institution did not submit any reply of Final Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 392nd Meeting held on 15th & 16th December. 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993. Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee noted that the institution has failed to submit reply / written representation in respect to the Final Show Cause Notice dt 21.11.2019 issued to the institution.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Mother Teresa College of Education, 669, Raigir Village, Bhongir Mandal, Nalgonda District - 508006,

Telangana for conducting **B.Ed**, course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Mother Teresa College of Education, 669, Raigir Village, Bhongir Mandal, Nalgonda District — 508006, Telangana for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 unit) w.e.f. the next academic session.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
