ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Kakinada College of Education, No. 2-178, Sarvodayanagar, Valsapakala, Kakinada – 533005, Andhra Pradesh run by Sarvodaya Educational Society, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS07535/B.Ed/2006-2007/781 dated 12.04.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 20.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, a corrigendum was issued to the institution vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS07535/B.Ed/AP/2015/76932 dated 24.10.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on 31.01.2019. The institution has submitted its reply show cause notice on 23.02.2019.

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 378th meeting held on 25th – 26th July, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 30.07.2019. The institution submitted vide letter dated 21.08.2019 & 31.08.2019 its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383rd meeting held on 07th to 09th January, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue withdrawal order. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a withdrawal order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS07535 /B.Ed/AP/2019/113617-3623 dated 15.01.2020 was issued to the institution.

7. AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. F.No.89-123/E-15841/2020 Appeal/17th Mtg-2020/1st September, 2020 dated 29.09.2020 and the Council remands back the case. The SRC in its 389th meeting held on 12th & 14th October and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 16.10.2020. The institution submitted vide letter dated 26.10.2020 its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice. The SRC in its 391st

meeting held on 3rd November 2020 and the Committee decided to write a letter to the institute to prove with the supporting documents regarding exclusive land, building and other infrastructural and in structural facilities exclusively for B.Ed. course. As per decision of SRC, a letter was sent to the institution on 06.11.2020. The institution has submitted reply in response to the letter on 11.11.2020 submitted reply to the alongwith land & building documents having address as Sy.No. 75/3,75/5,76/2,131/2,131/3, Door No. 2-178, Sarvodaya Nagar, Valasapakala, Vakalapudi Panchayat, Kakinada-533005, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh and staff list etc.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on 15th – 16th December, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Kakinada College of Education, S, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students.

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. Kakinada College of Education, Sy.No. 75/3,75/5,76/2,131/2,131/3, Door No. 2-178, Sarvodaya Nagar, Valasapakala, Vakalapudi Panchayat, Kakinada-533005, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh run by Sarvodaya Educational Society, Door No. 2-178, Sarvodaya Nagar, Valasapakala, Vakalapudi Panchayat, Kakinada-533005, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh for continuation of recognition for B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 50 students (1 basic unit) of subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

I.The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.

II.The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

III.The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

IV.The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

10. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

12. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

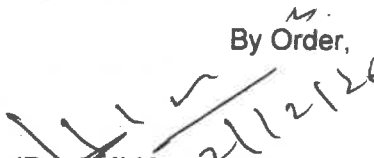
13. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

14. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

15. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
