WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, Seven Hills Teacher Training Institute, No. 11-435, 11<sup>th</sup> Street, Vinukonda Village, Post Taluk & City, Guntur District – 522647, Andhra Pradesh run by Zilla Vikalangula Sangam, No. 10-33, Dhakshanam Bazar Road, Vinukonda Village, Post Taluk & City, Guntur District – 522647, Andhra Pradesh for D.El.Ed, D.El.Ed-Al programme as per following details:-

- (i) The SRC vide Order No. F.No./SRCAPP483/D.Ed/AP/2013-14/54348 dt. 15.10.2013 for conducting D.El.Ed course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students.
- (ii) The SRC vide order No. F.No. SRO/NCTE/SRCAPP2409/D.EI.Ed-Al/AP/2016-2017/83425 dt.05.04.2016 for conducting D.EI.Ed-Al. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup>September, 2020 has taken the decision to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 21.09.2020.

**AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 389<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup>& 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee decided to recommend and request the NCTE Hqrs. to constitute One **Visiting Team** to report on the issues mentioned in the complaint / petition filed before the Andhra Pradesh State Minorities Commission, Mangalagiri for inspection of infrastructure & instructional facilities etc. of following institutionsu/s 13 of NCTE ACT, 1993.

**AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 392<sup>nd</sup> meeting held during 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. The institution has submitted notarized copy of building plan wherein the size of the multipurpose hall is not mentioned.

2. Principal & Eleven faculty Members (Assistant Professor) has been shown appointed after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2017, and they do not possess NET/Ph.D qualification as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2017.

3. The committee also gone through the contents of Notice for calling of Reports issued by the Andhra Pradesh State Minorities Commission, Mangalagiri, A.P. in Case Notice No. 14/2020 coupled with the complaint (contents of complainant are hidden as per guidelines of CVC) filed against the institution alleging about criminal activities and forgery in documents done by the management of the institution. The Committee considered that the allegations are very serious in nature.

Further, the Committee directed RD to issue a letter to NCTE Hqrs. for not conducting of inspection of this institution u/s 13 which was earlier decided by the Committee as the inspection u/s 13 is to be conducted for existing recognized institutions.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Seven Hills B.Ed College, thimmayapalem Road, Vinukonda, Door No. 11-434, Guntur-522647, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.Ed, & D.El.Ed-Al courses w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Seven Hills Teacher Training Institute, No. 11-435, 11<sup>th</sup> Street, Vinukonda Village, Post Taluk & City, Guntur District – 522647, Andhra Pradesh run by Zilla Vikalangula Sangam, No. 10-33, Dhakshanam Bazar Road, Vinukonda Village, Post Taluk & City, Guntur District – 522647, Andhra Pradesh for conducting for D.El.Ed, D.El.Ed-Al programme programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 150 students (3 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <a href="www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
