WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, Ameena D.El.Ed College, Plot No.375/3, Bastipadu Village and Post office, Kallur Taluk, Kurnool District- 518002, Andhra Pradesh run by B Haleema Educational Society, 87-520, Sri Nagar Colony, Kurnool Village, B-Camp Post, Kallur Taluk, Kurnool District - 518002, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order No.SRO/SRCAPP14481/D.El.Ed/AP/2016 /84200 dated 12.04.2016 for conducting D.El.Ed. Programme of two-years duration with an annual intake of two units of 50 students each from the academic session 2016-2017.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, a letter No. RC.No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.6.2020 is received from the Commissioner, School Education (FAC), School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh on 17.07.2020 recommending therein for derecognition order in respect of 188 Pvt. D.El.Ed. Colleges in A.P. since the said managements of Pvt. D.El.Ed. Colleges have made admission into the D.El.Ed. Course during academic year 2018-19 on their own in violation of Government orders.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by SRC in its  $386^{th}$  meeting held on  $23^{rd}-24^{th}$  July, 2020 and decided to issue a Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 17.08.2020. The institution has submitted the reply on 16.09.2020 in response to the Show Cause notice.
- **4. AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 401<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

1. The Committee in its 386<sup>th</sup> meeting after perusal of the letter No. RC.No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.6.2020 received from the Commissioner, School Education (FAC), School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh recommending therein for derecognition order in respect of 188 Pvt.D.El.Ed. colleges in A.P. since the said managements of Pvt.D.El.Ed. colleges have made admissions into the D.El.Ed. course during academic year 2018-19 on their own in violation of Government orders. Accordingly, the SRC decided to issue a Show

- Cause Notice to all such institutions asking therein to explain about the observations made by the School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh vide letter No. R.C.No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.6.2020.
- 2. In view of the above decision a Show Cause Notice dated 17.08.2020 was issued to the institution and the institution vide dated 16.09.2020 has submitted its representation. The institution failed to submit satisfactory explanation on the observation made by the School Education Department, Govt. of AP is not satisfactory as the institution made admission into the D.El.Ed. course during academic year 2018-19 on their own in violation of Govt. orders.
- 3. Further on perusal of the reply on 16.09.2020 submitted by the institution, the institution also failed to submit the following documents/information:
  - a) The institution has not satisfactorily replied with reference to irreigualrirties made by the institution as pointed out by the School Education Department Government of Andhra Pradesh vide letter No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.06.2020.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Ameena D.El.Ed College, Plot No.375/3, Bastipadu Village and Post office, Kallur Taluk, Kurnool District- 518002, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

5. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Ameena D.El.Ed College, Plot No.375/3, Bastipadu Village and Post office, Kallur Taluk, Kurnool District- 518002, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <a href="www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
