CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Jeevan College of Education, Trichy-Dindigul Main Road, Manapparai, Muthapudaiyanpatty Post, Trichy, Tamilnadu-621306 vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/M.Ed./2008/5099 dated 22.09.2008 for conducting Secondary M.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 25 students. The enhancement of intake from existing 25 to 35 is permitted on 25.08.2010.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 & for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 22.05.2015 for conducting M.Ed. courses of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 (one unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388th Meeting held on 14th & 15th September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT Repost accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, First Show Cause was issued to the institution on dt. 01.04.2019. The institution did not submitted reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th – 15th September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 08.01.2021 to B.Ed. Course. The institution submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice on 05.03.2021 for both courses.

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 397th meeting held on 25th – 26th March 2021 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Jeevan College of Education, Survey no. 232/7, 232/10, Mp Patty, Kannudaiyanpatty Panchayat Manapparai Trichy District-621306, Tamilnadu for the following courses: -

- (i) **B.Ed - 2 units (50 students in each unit).**
(ii) **M.Ed- 1 unit of 50 students.**

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Jeevan College of Education, Survey no. 232/7, 232/10, Mp Patty, Kannudaiyanpatty Panchayat Manapparai Trichy District-621306, Tamilnadu** run by **Jeevan Educational & Charitable Trust, Trichy District, Tamilnadu** for Continuation of recognition for M.Ed. programme for 1 unit of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
7. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
9. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.

- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

10. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

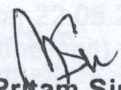
11. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

12. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.

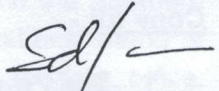
