## TO BE PUBLISHED IN GAZETTE OF INDIA PART III SECTION 4 WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Sri Sai Sirisha College of Education, Gandhinagar, Kasibugga, Srikakulam District-532 222, Andhra Pradesh has submitted an application for grant of recognition for B.Ed. course and recognition was granted to the institution on 19.04.2002.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 178<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2010 wherein the committee observed from records of the institution that the institutions were accorded recognition in the rented premises and they had not yet shifted to the permanent premises/building. In view of non-shifting of colleges to permanent building the committee decided to issue show cause notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act and obtain shifting fees and the documents for causing inspection for shifting.

AND WHEREAS, as per direction of SRC, Show Cause Notice was issued with request to submit relevant documents within 21 days of receipts of letter.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 201<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2011 considered the matter and decided to withdraw recognition which failed to shift to permanent premises within the prescribed time limit of three years as per the norms, and also they had failed to respond to show cause notice issued by SRC, NCTE long back on 29.05.2009.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 07.04.2011.

AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by the withdrawal of SRC, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Head quarters on 08.11.2011.

The council in its order dated 15.02.2011, "after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT report and after considering the oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was enough justification in remitting the matter to the SRC with a direction to cause inspection of the institution at the new premises within a month, after obtaining a payment of Rs. 40000/- from the institution and taking decision thereafter.

The Council remanded back the case of Sri Sai Sirisha college of Education, Srikakulam, Andhra Pradesh to the SRC, NCTE for necessary action as indicated above".

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 219<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> March 2012 considered the Council order dated 15.02.2012 and other relevant documents and decided to cause inspection at the new premises within a month after obtaining payment of Rs.40,000/- towards inspection fee, to examine whether the institution fulfils all the requirements as per the norms, for the proposed programme, subject to the condition that the deficiencies, if any, were duly rectified by the institution, under Section 14 (1) of NCTE Act.

AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the institution was fixed between 10<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2012 the same was intimated to the institution on 04.12.2012. The inspection of the institution was conducted on 12.12.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 237<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup> - 06<sup>th</sup> January 2013, considered the VT report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE Act.

AND WHEREAS, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 26.02.2013. The institution has submitted its written representation on 20.03.2013.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 244<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 09<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> May, 2013 considered the written reply of the institution on the above matter and also the relevant documents of the institution and decided to withdraw recognition from academic year 2013-14 is debarred from making any further admission subsequent to the date of issue of this order.

AND WHEREAS, a Withdrawal Recognition Order was issued to the institution vide F.No.APS00021/B.Ed/AP/2013-14/52171 dated 07.06.2013.

AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by the withdrawal recognition order of SRC, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs vide order no. F.No.89-480/2013 Appeal/14<sup>th</sup> Meeting-2013 dated 07.11.2013 and the appellate authority order stating as follows:

"...the council concluded that the SRC was justified in refusing recognition and therefore the appeal deserved to be rejected and the order of SRC confirmed.

Now therefore, the council hereby confirms the order appealed against."

AND WHEREAS, a court notice received from Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in W.P.No.32870 of 2013 filed by the institution.

AND WHEREAS, a Court Order received from the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh on 15.09.2015 in W.P. No. 32870 of 2013 dated 19.08.2015 stating as follows:

"It is not in dispute that the new regulations framed have come into force on 28.11.2014 and in terms of the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent has to consider the applications as per the new regulations.

Since the impugned order dated, 07.11.2013, is passed considering the petitioner's request under old regulations, the same is set aside and the matter is relegated to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to examine the petitioner's request in terms of new regulations and to pass appropriate orders.

The writ petition is disposed accordingly. The miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs".

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 292<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 considered the matter and decided that 1. Comply with the Court Order. 2. Collect fees as per new regulations. 3. Obtain documents as per new Regulations. Process and put up.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 25.11.2015. Now, the institution submitted its written representation on 12.05.2016 alongwith relevant documents and D.D. of Rs. 150.000/- for inspection fee.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 318<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 08<sup>th</sup> – 09<sup>th</sup> August 2016 considered the matter and decided as under:

1.Original application is not traceable. For completion of record, obtain a copy from the college. There is nothing on record to show commitment of the Society. Therefore, obtain a letter from the Society confirming that they sponsor the College.

2.Title to land is there. Land area is adequate.

3.LUC/EC are given.

4.BP/BCC are approved.

5. Original FDRs-not given.

6. Faculty list-only photocopy is given.

7.Fee-paid in full.

8.Cause Inspection.

9.Ask VT to collect all relevant documents. Give them full information about the grounds on which we had earlier withdrawn recognition.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted written representation on 28.12.2016. It's stated as under:

"...In continuation of the subject matter above cited I am to submit our Sri Sai Sirisha College of Education, Garudabhadra was closed during the academic session 2015-2016 mention the classes due to uneconomic strength.

Further I request you sir to be kind enough to cancel the concern FDR's related to the College. Here with I am submit the necessary information for closing the College."

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 329<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 06<sup>th</sup> & 07<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 considered the matter and decided as under:

- 1. The request for closure is accepted since all formalities have been completed.
- 2. Withdraw recognition for B.Ed.(2 units) w.e.f.2016-17.
- 3. Reject the application as withdrawn.
- 4. Return FDRs, if any.
- 5. Close the file.

NOW THEREFORE, the application of Sri Sai Sirisha College of Education, Gandhinagar, Kasibugga, Srikakulam District-532222, Andhra Pradesh for grant of recognition for B.Ed programme is hereby withdrawn w.e.f 2016-17 as per request of the institution.
