WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s14 of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Periyar University, Department of Education, Salem-636011, TamilNadu** vide SRC (NCTE) order no.F.SRC/NCTE/2009/M.Ed./RO/12001 dated 24.04.2009 for conducting M.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 25 students from the academic session 2009-2010. The enhancement of intake of 10 seats from existing 25 to 35 was permitted on 01.09.2010.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulation 2014 the institution has submitted affidavit dt.20.01.2015 for its willingness of one unit in M.Ed. course and adherence of provision of new Regulation. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 25.05.2015 for conducting M.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institution which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 27.02.2019. The institution vide letter dated 09.04.2019 reply to the show cause notice.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the Committee in its 380th meeting held on 18th – 19th September 2019. The Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 26.09.2019. The institution has submitted its reply on 13.11.2019 in respect of Final Show Cause Notice.

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th – 13th Feb 2020 and the Committee decided to send a Last Reminder letter. Accordingly, a Last Reminder letter was issued to the institution on 19.02.2020. The institution vide letter dated 02.03.2020 has submitted a reply in response to the Last Reminder letter.

6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 414th Meeting of SRC held on 26th – 27th September 2022 considered the matter and deficiency in reply to letter decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Last Reminder Letter (Letter). The institution has submitted its on 02.03.2020. The Committee perused the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. The institution has submitted a faculty list vide dated 20.02.2020 approved by the Registrar in-Charge, Periyar University consisting of one professor & Head, one professor, four Assistant Professor against the requirement of two professors, two associate professor and six assistant professors for **M.Ed. Course and the same faculty list has been submitted for B.Ed.-Part Time course.**

Hence the recognition granted to **Periyar University, Department of Education, Salem – 636011, Tamil Nadu for M.Ed. course** is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic year **2023-2024**. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn”.

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Periyar University, Department of Education, Salem – 636011, TamilNadu for conducting M.Ed. Programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (one unit)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2023-2024 onwards. Further, on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate counselling from the academic session i.e., **2023-2024** and the institution is also not permitted to take any fresh admission of students from the academic session **2023-2024**”.

8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
