ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution, namely Pope John Paul II College of Education, Roman Catholic Diocese of Kottar, Block A-5/22d, Block B-5/22e, Thiruvithancode, Mulagumoodu, Kalkulam, Kanyakumari 629167, Tamilnadu run by Roman Catholic Diocese of Kottar, Kalkulam, Kanyakumari, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an intake of 100 students on 05.06.2009.

2. AND WHEREAS, promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by a notarized affidavit dated 13.01.2015 consented to come under new Regulations. Thereafter, the Southern Regional Committee (NCTE) issued the revised provisional recognition order dt. 11.03.2015 to for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students [Two basic units of 50 students each] from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfilment of conditions mentioned therein.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted its written representation on 14/09/2015 along with documents regarding Requesting Change of Educational Agency.

4. AND WHEREAS, The SRC its 294th meeting held on 14, 15 & 16 November 2015 decided as under:-

Ask the institution to apply with necessary documents for change of name.

5. AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC letter sent to institution on 29.01.2016.

7. AND WHEREAS, The SRC its 314th meeting held on 27th and 28th May, 2016 decided as under:-

“For cases of B.Ed (2 Units) in the existing institution, where RPRO, has been issued, we have to cause inspection to check adherence to the 2014 Regulations. This action will have to be completed by July 2016 so that revised Formal Recognition can be issued w.e.f. 2016-17 to enable them to make admission in time.

- Action to check the documents in these cases (about 1885 in number) will take time. Instead of Waiting for that action to be completed for placing them before the SRC, to considered along with examination of the documents.
- Regional Director is authorized to intiate action accordingly. The institution concerned may be alerted about such action so that they will be prepared to

receive the Visiting Teams. They may also be advised to keep in readiness latest approved Faculty Lists for Submission to the VTs."

8. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of SRC, inspection intimation was sent to the institution on 14.06.2016. The institution submitted documents in compliance of revised recognition order on 29.10.2015 & 10.08.2016 regarding exempt from the inspection.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, The SRC its 322th meeting held on 20th -21st October, 2016 decided as under: -

1. Adequacy of the built-up area has to be verified again under the 2014 Regulations.
2. The request of the institution for exemption cannot be accepted.
3. Collect fee and cause inspection.
4. Ask them to complete action relating to change of name (as advised by us on 16 Novembre 2015) and then submit all documents in the new name.
5. Collect processing fee as processing by NCTE (H.Q)..

10. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of SRC letter sent to institution on 18.11.2016. The VT was conducted on 07.11.2016 and submitted its report on 10.11.2016.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

12. **AND WHEREAS**, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 04.09.2019. The institution has submitted its reply on dt. 13.10.2019 in respect of SCN issued above.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, the complicate submitted by the institution was considered by the SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th -27th November 2019 and committed decided as under: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the original documents and records made available in the file. The Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to Pope John Paul II College of Education, Roman Catholic Diocese of Kottar, Block A-5/22d, Block B-5/22e, Thiruvithancode, Mulagumoodu, Kalkulam, Kanyakumari 629167, Tamilnadu for B.Ed programme for 2 units (50 students each unit).

14. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution Pope John Paul II College of Education, Roman Catholic Diocese of Kottar, Block A-5/22d, Block B-5/22e, Thiruvithancode, Mulagumoodu, Kalkulam, Kanyakumari 629167, Tamilnadu for

continuation of conducting B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation form the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

15. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.

16. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

17. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.

- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
18. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
19. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
20. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
