CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Sree Sastha College of Education, Chennai – Bangalore Highway, Sree Sastha Nagar, Chembarambakkam, Chennai – 602103, Tamilnadu** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.TN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/4136 dated 22.11.2005 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 29.01.2015 & for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.04.2015 for conducting B.Ed. courses of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. As per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 07.05.2019. The institution has not submitted any reply in response to the Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 380th meeting held from 18-19 September 2019 constituted a Sub-Committee on a different issue also taken up the cases where the institutions have not submitted Show Cause Notice reply may also be issued a Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 23.10.2019.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the above matter was placed before the SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th – 27th November 2019. The committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 02.12.2019. The institution has not submitted any reply in response to the Final Show Cause Notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 389th meeting held on 12th – 14th October 2020 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, a Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution on 21.10.2020.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order no. F.No.89-292/E-172246/2020 Appeal/4th Mtg.-2020/21st January, 2021 dated 15.02.2021 appeal remand back the Order appealed against. The institution has submitted its reply on 17.02.2021 to the appeal remand back case.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, SRC in its 395th Meeting held on 25th & 26th February 2021 and has considered the matter and the committee decided to issue a Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 10.03.2021. the institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice on dt. 01.03.2021 & 16.03.2021 on the following points: -

1. At the time of a recognition the institution submitted a copy of Sale Deed dt. Executed on 03.11.1998. In response to appeal reply the institution submitted sale deed dt. 25.08.2000.
2. The institution has submitted notarized copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate in regional language.
3. The institution has submitted notarized copy of Building Completion Certificate but not approved by the Competent authority.
4. In addition to the above, the institution is required to submit the point wise reply to the Final Show Cause Notice dt. 12.12.2019 and reasons thereof for non-submission of reply on which the recognition of the institution was withdrawn.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 397th meeting held on 25th - 26th March 2021 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution and decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Sree Sastha College of Education, Survey No. 183/2B, 213/11, Chennai-Bangalore Highway, Sree Sastha Nagar, Chembarambakka, Chennai-600123, Tamilnadu** for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic unit of 50 students.

Further, the Committee decided to issue **Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993** for M.Ed. programme seeking the following documents before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 21 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

- (i) Latest faculty list for M.Ed. programme duly approved by the affiliating University.

10. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Sree Sastha College of Education, Survey No. 183/2B, 213/11, Chennai-Bangalore Highway, Sree Sastha Nagar, Chembarambakka, Chennai-600123, Tamilnadu** run by **A.M. Kannappa Mudaliar & A.M.K. Jambulinga Mudaliar Educational trust, No. 339, P.H. Road, Near Pachaappas College, Tolgate Bus Stop, Aminjikai, Chennai 600029, Tamilnadu** for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 100 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

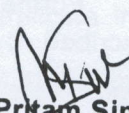
- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
11. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
12. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
13. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
15. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
16. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.



If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.

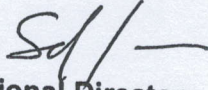
