ORDER

AND WHEREAS, on 30.01.2015, the institution submitted an affidavit affirming adherence to Regulations, 2014. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 25.05.2015 for offering B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 100 students (2 units of 50 students each) subject to fulfillment of certain conditions mentioned therein.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th – 13th February, 2020 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition on the grounds mentioned therein. Accordingly, a withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide dt.21.02.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide order No. F.No.89-223/E-167242/2020 Appeal/29th Mtg.-2020/02nd December, 2020/95605 dt.16.12.2020 remanded back the matter to SRC. The operative part of the order is as under :-

"AND WHEREAS after perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online presentation of appeal, Appeal Committee concluded to remand back the case to SRC for revisiting the matter after required documents are submitted by the appellant institution within 15 days of the issue of appeal order."

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dt. 18.01.2021 submitted compliance / documents in response to SCN.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 394th Virtual Meeting held from 27th - 28th January 2021 decided as under: -

"On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Paulsons

Teacher Training College, Paulsons Nagar, Pullichapallam, Vanur Taluk, Villupuram district, Tamil Nadu 605109 for M.Ed programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."

NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution **Paulsons Teacher Training College, S. No. 132/1A, 2A, 3A,4A, 253/1A2, 298/6A, 299/1B, Paulsons Nagar, Pulichapallam 605109, Vanur Taluk, Villupuram District, Tamil Nadu** run by **Pauls Educational Trust, No. 12, hails Road, Kilpauk Chennai 600010** for continuation of conducting **M.Ed course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **one basic unit of 50 students** subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation form the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
5. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self - Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
8. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter - alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information regarding the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;

15. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.

- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

9. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

10. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

11. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
