WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Sri Srinivasa College of Education, H.No.10/7486, Sitaramanagar, Koilkuntla, Kurnool-518134, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Srinivasa Educational Society, Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/2402 dt.10.05.2007 for conducting B.Ed. (Secondary) course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2006-2007.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 22.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 19.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students from the academic session 2015-16 with a condition to maintain.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 297th meeting held during 27th – 28th December 2015 considered and decided to issue a letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution vide dated 03.02.2016. Thereafter, the institution has submitted written representation vide letter dated 19.12.2016. The SRC in its 329th meeting held on 06th – 07th February 2017 considered the matter and decided to issue a letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution vide dated 01.03.2017.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 393rd meeting held on 05th – 06th January 2021 considered and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 08.01.2021. The institution has not submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice till date.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 395th Meeting held on 25th - 26th February 2021 and considered the matter as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

1. The Committee noted that due to non-compliance of SCN dated 01.03.2017 for submission of requisite documents to verify infrastructure & instructional facilities a Final Show Cause Notice dated 08.01.2021 was issued to the institution. However, the institution failed to submit the requisite documents as per Final Show Notice dated 08.01.2021.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to **Sri Srinivasa College of Education, H.No.10/7486, Sitaramanagar, Koilkuntla, Kurnool-518134, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed. course with effect from the next academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Sri Srinivasa College of Education, H.No.10/7486, Sitaramanagar, Koilkuntla, Kurnool-518134, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Srinivasa Educational Society, Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of (2 units) 100 students (B.Ed) course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
