WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14 of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, Narayana College of Education, Padarupalli, A.K. Nagar Post, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh-524004 run by Narayana Educational Society, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh vide vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2007-2008/12610 dt. 05:10.2007 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

- AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 22.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 26.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units from the academic session 2015-16.
- AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted written representation dt. 18.02.2022 for closure of B.Ed. Programme. The SRC in its 408th Meeting held on 02nd March, 2022 considered the request and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee agreed to close down the institution as requested by the institution vide dated 20.04.2018, 26.11.2021 & 18.02.2022 by withdrawing the recognition granted to Narayana College of Education, Padarupalli. A.K. Nagar Post, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh-524004 for conducting B.Ed. Programme under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2022-2023.

However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director as per the general resolution taken by the SRC in this meeting."

- NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Narayana College of Education, Padarupalli, A.K. Nagar Post, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh-524004 run by Narayana Educational Society, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 basic units) with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

6. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order.
