WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Sathyasai B.Ed. College, Thiruvallur, Paruthipet Village, Avadi Town, No.7, Rajaji Street, Poonamallee Taluk, paruthipet City, Thiruvallur District-600071, TamilNadu** vide order no. F.No.SRC/NCTE/SRCAPP201630219/M.Ed./1Unit/362ndMeeting/2018/97913,14,15,16,17, 18 dt. 29.08.2018 for conducting M.Ed. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (1 Unit) from the academic session 2019-2020.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 404th meeting held on 16th – 17th November, 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 30.11.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 08.12.2021.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 406th Meeting held on 19th January 2022 considered the reply to Final Show Cause Notice and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 08.12.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. *The institution vide Final Show Cause Notice dt. 30.11.2021 was informed to submit the latest approval of faculty (for B.Ed., M.Ed. and B.Sc.B.Ed. courses) issued by the affiliating University but the institution had submitted the old approval of faculty issued by the University in 2017, 2018 and 2019. Accordingly, the institution failed in submission of latest approval of faculty.*
2. *The building plan submitted by the institution is neither approved nor legible.*
3. *The institution submitted the BCC wherein the built up area for B.Ed., B.Sc. B.Ed. and M.Ed. have been shown as 2039.68 sq.mtrs., 2146.7 sq.mtrs. and 483.97 sq.mtrs. respectively. The built up area 483.97 sq.mtrs. is not sufficient as stipulated under clause 7.1 of Appendix 5 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
4. *The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
5. *The institution did not submit details of administrative and professional staff as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*



6. ***The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.***

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Sathyasai B.Ed. College, no.7, Rajaji Street, kamarajar Nagar, Avadi, Chennai-600071, TamilNadu for conducting B.Ed., B.Sc.B.Ed. & M.Ed.programmewith effect from the academic session i.e. 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above”.

4. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Sathyasai B.Ed. College, no.7, Rajaji Street, kamarajar Nagar, Avadi, Chennai-600071, TamilNadu** run by **Dr. Rajalakshmi Sundarajan Educational Society, Chennai-600071, TamilNadu** for conducting **M.Ed. Programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (1 Unit)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

5. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

6. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
