WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution was granted recognition namely Sri Lalitha Devi D.Ed. College, Plot No. 206/2, Street 1, Rajampalli Village & Post Office, Darsi Taluk 7 City, Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh-523247 run by Humayen Educational Society, Plot No. 5-1410, Kurichedu Road, Durai Vilalge & Post Office, Darsi Taluk & City, Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh-523247 granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/AP/D.El.Ed./2016-17/84847 dated 02.05.2016 for conducting D.El.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of two units 50 students each from the academic sessions 2016-2017.

AND WHEREAS, a letter No. RC. No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.06.2020 is received from the Commissioner, School Education (FAC), School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh on 17.07.2020 recommending therein for de-recognition order in respect of 188 Pvt. D.El.Ed Colleges in A.P. since the said managements of Pvt. D.El.Ed Colleges have made admission into the D.El.Ed Course during academic year 2018-19 on their own in violation of Government orders.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by SRC in its 386th meeting held on 23rd - 24th July, 2020 considered decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 21.08.2020. Thereafter, the matter placed before the SRC in its 393rd Meeting held on 05th -06th January 2021 considered and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 11.01.2021. Thereafter, the institution has submitted its reply to Final Show Cause Notice along with the documents vide letter dt. 08.02.2021.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 395th Meeting held on 25th & 26th February 2021 and considered the matter as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee has perused the reply submitted by the institution on 08.02.2021 in response to the Final Show Cause Notice. The Committee observed the following deficiencies: -

1. The institution has not submitted faculty list in prescribed format.
2. The institution has submitted Building Plan which is not legible.
3. The institution has not submitted Site Plan duly approved by the competent authority.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to Sri Lalitha Devi D.Ed. College, Plot No.206/2, Street 1, Rajampalli Village & Post Office, Darsi Taluk & City, Prakasam District-523247, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Sri Lalitha Devi D.Ed. College, Plot No.206/2, Street 1, Rajampalli Village & Post Office, Darsi Taluk & City, Prakasam District-523247, Andhra Pradesh run by Humayen Educational Society, Plot No. 5-1410, Kurichedu Road, Durai Vilalge & Post Office, Darsi Taluk & City, Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh-523247 for conducting D.El.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) 50 students each for (D.El.Ed) course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
