WITHDRAWAL ORDER

**WHEREAS**, the institution namely **Kevi Women's College of Education, S. No. 6,7,8 Saminaickenpatti Village, Omalur Taluk, Salem – 636001, Tamil Nadu** was granted recognition for conducting **(B.Ed.)** course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide SRC, NCTE order no.:F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/8644 dt 24.10.2006 from the academic session 2006-2007.

**AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 10.03.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

**AND WHEREAS**, revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 29.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2015-16.**

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 and Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institution which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 16.09.2019. **The institution has not submitted any reply in respect of Show Cause Notice.**

**AND WHEREAS**, the grounds / lapse of disaffiliation of TEIs communicated vide e-mail dt. 11.02.2020 are placed on the table of the Committee along with the original files. The institution along with regulatory file was placed before the SRC in its 384<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020 and the Committee decided to issue a Final Show Cause Notice vide dated 10.08.2020. **The institution has not submitted any reply till date.**

**AND WHEREAS**, the matter was finally considered the SRC in its 395<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

**"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -**



1. The Committee noted that due to non-compliance of SCN dated 16.09.2019 for submission of requisite documents to verify infrastructure & instructional facilities a Final Show Cause Notice dated 10.08.2020 was issued to the institution. However the institution failed to submit the requisite documents as per Final Show Notice dated 10.08.2020.
2. Further the SRC also given the last opportunity for submission of written representation/reply by way of last Reminder letter dated 21.09.2020 and the institution failed to submit the reply to the last reminder letter.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Kevi Women's College of Education, S. No. 6,7,8 Saminaickenpatti Village, Omalur Taluk, Salem – 636001, Tamil Nadu for conducting **B.Ed., M.Ed. & D.T.Ed.** courses with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

**NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Kevi Women's College of Education, S. No. 6,7,8 Saminaickenpatti Village, Omalur Taluk, Salem – 636001, Tamil Nadu** run by **Kevi Educational Trust, No.1, Kevi Complex, Bazaar Street, Nearby Old Bus Stand, Salem, Tamilnadu** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students each w.e.f the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org), with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
