WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **St. Anne's B.Ed. College for Women, J.A. College Campus, Periyakulam-625601, Theni District, TamilNadu run Sisters of St. Anne of Tiruchirappalli, Mount St. Anne, Thamaraiakula, Periyakulam Post-625601, Theni District, TamilNadu** vide SRC order No. F.No.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/4915 dt. 23.12.2005 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 13.01.2015. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 14.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 has considered the matter and the Committee decided to issue a Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 03.05.2019. The institution vide letter dated 27.05.2019 has submitted in response to the Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14-15 Sept 2020 has considered the matter and the Committee decided to issue a Final Show Cause Notice to the institution on 21.09.2020. The institution vide dated 22.10.2020 submitted reply in response to Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 395th meeting held on February 25-26, 2021, and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 22.10.2020 in response to the Final Show Cause Notice. The Committee found the following deficiency:-

1. The institution has not submitted a Certified copy of Land Documents.
2. The institution has submitted a photocopy of NON - ENCUMBRANCE CERTIFICATE IN Regional Language.
3. The institution has submitted a photocopy of Building Plan which is not approved by the Competent Authority and Multi-purpose hall area is not readable in the document.

4. The institution has submitted a photocopy of Completion Certificate which is not in Prescribed format of NCTE.
5. The institution has submitted a computerized copy of Faculty List which not in prescribed format of NCTE.
6. The institution has not submitted Form "A" issued by the Branch Manager, only photocopy of FDRs submitted.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to the institution namely, **St. Anne's B.Ed. College for Women, J.A. College Campus, Periyakulam-625601, Theni District, TamilNadu** for conducting B.Ed. course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **St. Anne's B.Ed. College for Women, J.A. College Campus, Periyakulam-625601, Theni District, TamilNadu** run by **Sisters of St. Anne of Tiruchirappalli, Mount St. Anne, ThamaraiKula, Periyakulam Post-625601, Theni District, TamilNadu** for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) w.e.f. the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
