CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **J. Beera College of Education, Seetaramapuram Village, Narasapuram Mandal, West Godavari Andhra Pradesh** vide order no.F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2007-2008/11443 dt.17.09.2007 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 17.01.2015. A revised provisional recognition order was issued on 06.05.2015 to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted written representation vide letter dated 06.01.2017 request for one basic unit.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22nd Oct., 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institutions have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply been submitted. The Sub-Committee decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.10.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th – 15th September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause was issued to the institution on 02.03.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 26.03.2021.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 409th meeting held on 29th – 30th March, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC withdrawal order no. F.SRC/NCTE/APS07002/B.Ed./AP/2022/131207-131211 dated 07.04.2022 was issued to the institution.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi bearing W.P (C) No.14114/2022 & CM APPL. 43125/2022 titled as J.Beera College of Education versus National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. Whereby the Hon'ble High Court has directed that: -

“The NCTE is directed to reflect the status of the Petitioner as a recognised institution for the year 2022-23 on its website. The NCTE is also directed to communicate the same to the Petitioner’s affiliating university and the concerned State Government within one week from today.

The Appellate Committee of the NCTE shall endeavour to dispose of the Petitioner’s appeal as expeditiously as possible and practical, and not later than three months from today.”

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 415th meeting held on 3rd – 04th November, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue a letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 17.11.2022.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order dated 07.04.2022 of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order no. 89-243/E-276758/2022 Appeal/8th meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202214442 dated 16.11.2022 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution vide letter dated 19.11.2022 submitted reply to the appeal remand back order.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 417th meeting held on 01st – 02nd December, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 12.12.2022. The institution has submitted reply on 20.1.2023.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 421st Meeting held on 10th February, 2023 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

“The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

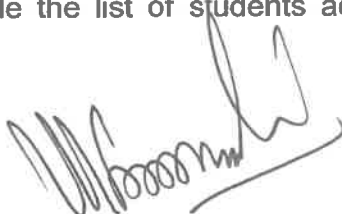
The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the **continuation order** be issued to the Institution **J. Beera College of Education, Survey No. 236, Seetharampuram North Panchayat, Narasapuram Mandal, West Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh** for **B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students.**”

12. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., **J. Beera College of Education, Survey No. 236, Seetharampuram North Panchayat, Narasapuram Mandal, West Godavari District-534275, Andhra Pradesh** for Continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. programme** for two years duration with an annual intake of **1 basic unit of 50 students** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.



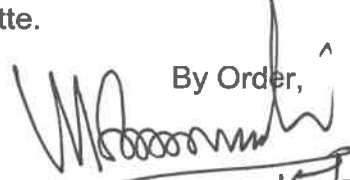
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
13. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
14. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
15. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
16. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
17. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.



18. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.

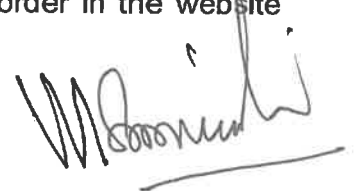
