WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS the institution namely **Sree Sastha College of Education, Chennai – Bangalore Highway, Sree Sastha Nagar, Chembarambakkam, Chennai – 602103, Tamilnadu** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/M.Ed./2006-2007 / 14899 dt. 16.11.2007 for conducting M.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 25 students.

AND WHEREAS, the enhancement of intake of 10 seats from existing 25 to 35 was permitted to the institution on 26.08.2010.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 17.10.2014 for its willingness of one unit in M.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.05.2015 (P-348/Coors.) for conducting M.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the institution namely **Sree Sastha College of Education, Chennai – Bangalore Highway, Sree Sastha Nagar, Chembarambakkam, Chennai – 602103, Tamilnadu** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.TN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006 / 4136 dt. 22.11.2005 (P-265/Coors.) for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 29.01.2015 (P-271/Coors.) for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.04.2015 (P-274/Coors.) for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

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AND WHEREAS, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 01.05.2019. The institution submitted its reply along with documents on dt. 10.06.2019.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 07.05.2019 for B.Ed. course.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 380th Meeting held from 18-19 September 2019 constituted a Sub-Committee on a different issue also taken up the cases where the institutions have not submitted Show Cause Notice reply may also be issued a Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution for B.Ed. course on dt. 23.10.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 389th meeting held on 12th & 14th October 2020 and considered the matter as under: -

“The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 12.12.2019.

1. The institution has failed in submission of written representation along with all required documents in response to Final Show Cause Notice.

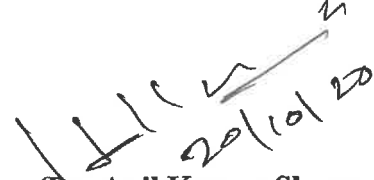
NOW THEREFORE, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Sree Sashta College of Education, Chennai – Bangalore Highway, Sree Sashta Nagar, Chembarambakkam, Chennai – 602103, TamilNadu** for conducting **B.Ed. & M.Ed. courses w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993** on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

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Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
