**CONTINUATION ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, recognition u/s 15 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Periyar University, Department of Education, Salem, Tamilnadu-636011** vide order no. F.SRC/NCTE/2009/M.Ed./RO/12001 dt. 24.04.2009 for conducting **M.Ed.** course of one year duration with an annual intake of 25 students from the academic session 2009-2010. The enhancement of intake of 10 seats from existing 25 to 35 was permitted vide order dt. 01.09.2010.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulation 2014 the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 20.01.2015 for its willingness of one unit in M.Ed. course and adherence of provision of new Regulation. Thereafter, the Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 25.05.2015 for conducting M.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 has considered the matter and decide to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution dt. 27.02.2019. The institution has submitted reply of Show Cause Notice vide letter dt. 09.04.2019.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 380<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution dt. 26.09.2019. The institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice vide letter dt. 13.11.2019.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 384<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 has considered the matter and decided to issue last reminder (Letter) to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC last reminder (Letter) was issued to the institution on 19.02.2020. The institution has submitted reply of last reminder (Letter) vide letter dt. 02.03.2020.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 414<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue Withdrawal order. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, Withdrawal Order No. F.SRC/NCTE/APSO4603/M.Ed./TN/2022/136299-136302 dt. 14.10.2022 was issued to the University for M.Ed. programme.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the University preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-110/E-304549/2023 Appeal/7<sup>th</sup> Meeting, 2023 APPLSRC202214487 dt. 13.07.2023 appeal remand back the case to SRC with a direction to consider the documents. The institution has submitted reply/documents as directed by appeal committee vide letter dt. 14.07.2023.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 428<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 has considered the matter and decided to issue a letter to the institution. Accordingly, as per the

decision of SRC letter was issued to the institution dt. 12.09.2023. In response to the minutes uploaded decision on SRC official website the institution has submitted a reply vide letter dt. 29.08.2023.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 429<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 has considered the matter and decided to issue a letter to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 25.10.2023. The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dt. 10.11.2023.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 430<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 01<sup>st</sup> December, 2023 has considered the matter and decided as follows: -

*“The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -*

*The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Periyar University Department of Education, Salem, Tamilnadu-636011 for M.Ed. programme 1 basic unit of 50 students.”*

11. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issues permitting the institution i.e., **Periyar University Department of Education, Salem, Tamilnadu-636011** for Continuation of recognition for **M.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **1 basic unit of 50 students** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

12. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

13. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

14. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land,



building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
- f. Available infrastructural facilities.
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

16. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

17. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
