GRANT PROVISIONAL RECOGNITION

11 SEP 2024

WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Omsai Com B.Ed College, Plot/Khasara No. 4-17 (S No. 77), Street No. 4-17, Maddi Post, Padmanabham Taluk & City, Vishakhapatnam District – 531219, Andhra Pradesh** vide order No. F.SRO/NCTE/SRCAPP14227/B.Ed/AP/2016-2017/83590 dated 05.04.2016 for conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two years duration with an annual intake of (one basic unit) of 50 students from the academic session 2016-2017.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted written representation vide letter dated 19.06.2024.

3. AND WHEREAS, a Writ Petition (W.P. No. 12364 of 2024) was filed by the institute before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh and the court issued a verbal direction on 28.06.2024 to SRC for considering to increase the intake of students from 50 to 100 students for 2 year B.Ed. Course in accordance with NCTE Rules and Regulations.

4. AND WHEREAS, in Obedience of the Hon'ble Court's Verbal direction the matter was put up for consideration in 440th Meeting held on 03th-04th July 2024 and 441st Meeting held on 04th August 2024 of SRC where it was decided by the Committee that:-

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE ACT 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations:-

The Committee observed that para 5.2 of the New Education Policy 2020 provides the following:-

"To ensure that outstanding students enter the teaching profession- especially from the rural areas-a large number of merit based scholarships shall be instituted across the country for studying quality 4 year integrated B.Ed. programme,"

In view of the above, the SRC decides that permission u/s 15(3) to 2 year B.Ed course is not accepted. Hence the SRC decided to wait for the final outcome of the Writ Petition filed by the institute."

5. AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 30.08.2024. Meanwhile, the Court passed an Interim direction in WP 12364/2024, where the Court vide order dated 26.07.2024 directed the following:

"Despite two opportunities were given to furnish written instructions/filing of Counter Affidavit, the respondents have not responded. Therefore, there shall be a direction to the respondents to permit the petitioner college to admit students intake for B.Ed courses for the academic year 2024/25 in the meeting of the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE held on 20.06.2024, subject to the result of the Writ Petition.

Petitioner-College is also directed to inform the students that their admissions are subject to the result of the writ petition."

6. AND WHEREAS, in regards to the above Interim Direction, the Contempt Petition was filed in Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh praying that the Petitioner College has submitted the representation for increase in intake of the students but SRC has not considered the case of the Petitioner.

7. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 442nd Meeting held on 05th September, 2024 considered the and decided as under:-

"The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -


In obedience of order dated 26.07.2024 in WP No. 12364 of 2024 by Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh, the SRC considered the matter along with Court's direction and decided to Grant Provisional Recognition for additional 50 seats to Omsai Com B.Ed College, subject to the outcome of WP 12364/2024. As per the direction of the Court, the College is also directed to inform the students that their admissions are subject to the result of the Writ Petition."

8. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Omsai Com B.Ed College, Plot/Khasara No. 4-17 (S No. 77); Street No. 4-17, Maddi Post, Padmanabham Taluk & City, Vishakhapatnam District – 531219, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting (B.Ed.) programme for two year duration with an intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-2016 and additional intake of 50 students (Existing 50 intake + Additional 50 intake) thus making total intake of 100 students (Two basic units) from the academic session 2024-2025 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Regulation Norms & Procedure) Regulation, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

(a) The institution shall adhere to the fulfilment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, and ensure the following before commencement of the session:-

- (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of Clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall comply with condition laid down in clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended vide Notification on 29.04.2017. which provides as under:-

- *An institution, which has been recognised by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency identified by the Council within five years of the date of recognition.*
- *All existing Teacher Education Institutions which have not been accredited so far or have not been accredited within five years from the date of its recognition shall be required to get themselves*



- accredited by the aforesaid accrediting agency within a period of one year from the date of notification of these Regulations.
- The accreditation once obtained shall be valid for a period of five years and the recognised and already accredited Teacher Education Institutions shall be required to get accreditation renewed by the agency identified for the purpose by the Council before the lapse of the earlier accreditation.

- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) The Norms for teaching staff in respect of their qualifications and experience shall be as per provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time.

9. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable, and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt. and also the concerned recognized Institution:-

- (i) The affiliating body/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 before grant of affiliating to the institution.
- (ii) The affiliating university shall ensure that the norms including the norms of Faculty for offering B.Ed-AI. component of the programme as per curriculum of these programme in the University, is scrupulously observed.
- (iii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is a composite institution as per definition of a "composite institution" given in the NCTE Regulations, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not a composite institution, the recognition granted shall be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, the existing stand-alone institutions.
- (iv) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake, at any stage, the recognitions granted shall be treated as withdrawn, and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.

10. The institution shall submit a Self-Appraisal Report to the Regional Committee at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

11. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display as mandatory disclosure the following:-

- (i) Copy of Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition Order



(v) Information regarding fulfilment of norms & standards and other conditions for the course.

12. In case, if the land is in the name of the Society/Trust, the land is to be transferred within six months from the date of recognition order in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated for withdrawal of recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the Regional Committee along with new land documents within the stipulated time.


13. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by the MHRD.

14. The Institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month from the date of issue of this order.

15. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations, the Regional Committee shall withdraw recognition under provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

16. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.


