WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Haji Kareem College of Education, Khasra No. 07, Near Govt, Hospital, Plot No. 7-116, Brahmanakotkur Village, Nandikotkur Taluka, Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh-518432** vide order No. F.APSO9641/B.Ed./AP/201130569 dated 29.09.2011 for conducting **B.Ed. course** of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred) students from the academic session 2011-2012.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution had consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 14.05.2015. A revised provisional recognition order was issued on 18.03.2015 to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22nd Oct., 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institution has not submitted requisite documents or only part reply has been submitted. The Sub-Committee decided to issue SCN in all such cases seeking documents in compliance of RPRO matters. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.10.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 13.11.2019.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th – 13th February, 2020 has considered the matter decided to issue a letter. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 26.02.2020. The institution has not given any response to the letter dated 26.02.2020 and also has not deposited inspection fee.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 412th Meeting held on 05th & 06th July, 2022 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

- (i) *The institution failed to pay prescribed fee for inspection of their institution as informed. Therefore, it is construed that the Management is not interested for inspection.*

As such the recognition granted to Haji Kareem College of Education, Khasra No.07, Near Govt, Hospital, Plot No.7.116, Brahmanakotkur Village, Nandikotkur Taluka, Kurnool District-518732, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed. course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the end of next academic session i.e. 2023-2024. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted

under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counselling / making admissions from the next academic session i.e. 2023-2024."

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Haji Kareem College of Education, Khasra No.07, Near Govt, Hospital, Plot No.7.116, Brahmanakotkur Village, Nandikotkur Taluka, Kurnool District-518732, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed. Programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (two basic units)** with effect from the end of next academic session i.e., **2023-2024**. Further, *on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the academic session stands withdrawn.* Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate for counseling from the academic session i.e., **2023-2024** and the institution is also not permitted to take any fresh admission of students from the academic session **2023-2024**.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
