WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Amrita Shikshana Mahavidyalya, Mysore, Karnataka run by Amrita Shikshana Mahavidyalya, Mysore, Karnataka vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO1995/B.Ed/2004-2005/8832 dt. 30.11.2004 for conducting B.Ed course of two-years duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

AND WHEREAS, the Amrita Shikshana Mahavidyalya, Mysore, Karnataka vide its letter dated 23.06.2007 requested for change in the name from Amrita Shikshana Mahavidyalya, Mysore, Karnataka to Amrita School of Education, Mysore.

AND WHEREAS, the change of name was permitted in SRC's 138th meeting held on from 24th to 26thJuly, 2007 and the institution was informed vide letter dated 5.10.2007.

AND WHEREAS, the Amrita School of Education, Mysore, Karnataka submitted an affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for 2 units of B.Ed course .Accordingly a Revised Provisional Recognition Order dated 16.5.2015 was issued for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 21.5.2015 requested for one basic unit (50 students) only and a corrigendum was issued on 5.04.2016 allowing the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 379th meeting held on 21st& 22nd August, 2019 considered the matter and finally decided to issue continuation of recognition order. Accordingly as per the decision of SRC a continuation of recognition order was issued to the institution on 02.09.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 28.11.2019 submitted a written representation. The SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 7th, 8th and 9th January 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The Committee decided that to withdraw the recognition granted to Amrita School of Education, No.114, 7th Cross, Bogadi 2nd Stage, Mysure-570026 Karnataka for conducting B.Ed & B.Sc. B.Ed (Integrated) courses under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 09.12.2019. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order.
