ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution namely Sree Ramakrishna College of Education, Padanilam, Kulasekharam, Kanyakumari, Tamilnadu was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 seats vide SRC, NCTE's order dt. 02.11.2005.

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the NCTE Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure). Regulations, 2014 were notified on 01.12.2014 in supersession of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2009.

AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the duration of the B.Ed. course was increased from one year to two years and the existing institutions offering B.Ed. course, of one-year duration, were required to give their acceptance, in the form of an affidavit, for adherence of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted its willingness and adherence of new regulations through an Affidavit dt. 13.01.2015.

AND WHEREAS, a provisional revised recognition order dt. 01.05.2015 was issued to the institution for conducting B.Ed. course of two years' duration with an annual intake of 100 seats (two units).

AND WHEREAS, on the basis of a general decision taken by the SRC in its 314th meeting a letter for conducting inspection of the institution was issued on 14.06.2016 but the inspection has not been carried out till date.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, vide letters dt. 30.09.2016, 09.12.2016, 28.12.2016. 07.02.2017 and recently 22.07.2019 the institution had requested to dispense with the B.Ed. course in the college from the academic session 2017-18.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18th -19th September 2019 considered the matter and decided as under: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee decided that to withdraw the recognition granted to Sree Ramakrishna College of Education, Padanilam, Kulasekharam, Kanyakumari, Tamil Nadu for conducting B.Ed. course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 22.07.2019. Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- (a) NOC from the affiliating body.
- (b) NOC from the staff/faculty.
- (c) Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Sree Ramakrishna College of Education, Padanilam, Kulasekharam, Kanyakumari, Tamilnadu granted SRC vide order no. F.TN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/3770 dt. 2.11.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order. The provisional revised recognition orders No.F.SRO/NCTE/APSO3905/B.Ed/TN/2014-15/63832 dt. 01.5.2015 issued to the institution in respect of B.Ed course of 2 years duration with an annual intake of 100 seats is also hereby withdrawn.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "Online mode" available on NCTE's website http://ncte.gov.in, within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
