WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Kamarajar College of Education, No. 16, Yethapur Road, Puthiragoundanpalayan, Salem - 636119, Tamilnadu vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/8442 dated 06.10.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2006-2007.

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the NCTE Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure). Regulations, 2014 were notified on 01.12.2014 in supersession of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2009.

AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the duration of the B.Ed. course was increased from one year to two years and the existing institutions offering B.Ed. course, of one-year duration, were required to give their acceptance, in the form of an affidavit, for adherence of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavit submitted by the institution dt. 27.04.2015, the Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 29.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students each for (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned therein.

And whereas, the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th - 13th February, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 02.05.2019. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 25.11.2019. The institution did not submit its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN).

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Kamarajar College of Education, No. 16, Yethapur Road, Puthiragoundanpalayan, Salem - 636119, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Kamarajar College of Education, No. 16, Yethapur Road, Puthiragoundanpalayan, Salem – 636119, Tamilnadu vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/8442 dated 06.10.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
