WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely **Raja Foundation College of Education, Kona Raod, Mylavaram, Kadapa-516439, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Raja Foundation Care and Share Charitable Trust, Kadapa, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO7201/B.Ed/2007-2008/11442 dt. 17.09.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 21.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 363rd meeting held during 17th to 19th September, 2018 considered the matter and decided to issue show cause notice to the institution. Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 16.10.2018. **The institution did not reply to the show cause notice till date.**

AND WHEREAS, the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18th – 19th September, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 10.10.2019. The institution submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice on 31.10.2019 along with documents.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 7th, 8th and 9th January 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 16.10.2018. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 10.10.2019. The institution vide letter dated 31.10.2019 submitted its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). On perusal of the same the Committee found the following defects / shortcomings / deficiencies as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which are as under:-

- (i) The Committee noted that the land allotted to the institution is meant for construction of Shelter for Rehabilitation of Destitute, orphan children. The building plan submitted by the institution was not approved by the competent authority. The institution has not made any attempt to create infrastructure for running the teacher education programme exclusively.
- (ii) The institution has not appointed the faculty of Fine Arts & Performing Arts.

- (iii) The institution has not submitted Form A FDRs towards Reserve Fund & Endowment Fund.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Raja Foundation College of Education, Kona Road, Mylavaram, Kadapa, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Raja Foundation College of Education, Kona Raod, Mylavaram, Kadapa-516439, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Raja Foundation Care and Share Charitable Trust, Kadapa, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
