WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Sri Sai Aditya College of Education, No.46-8-10, Church Square Area, Jaganikpur, Kakinada, East Godavari District-533002, Andhra Pradesh run by Aditya Academy, Kakinada, East Godavari, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2007-2008/13322 dt. 23.10.2007 for conducting B.ED course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2007-2008.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A Revised Provisional Recognition order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, a Corrigendum vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO8954/B.Ed/AP/2015/74734 dated 05.10.2015 was issued to the institution for one basic unit.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 368th meeting held on 08th - 09th January, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 18.01.2019. The institution vide letter dated 04.10.2019 submitted its reply to show cause notice. The SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th - 27th November, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee decided that to withdraw the recognition granted to Sri Sai Aditya College of Education, No.46-8-10, Church Square Area, Jaganikpur, Kakinada, East Godavari District-533002, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 04.10.2019. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- (a) NOC from the affiliating body.
- (b) NOC from the staff/faculty.

(c) Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Sri Sai Aditya College of Education, No.46-8-10, Church Square Area, Jaganikpur, Kakinada, East Godavari District-533002, Andhra Pradesh run by Aditya Academy, Kakinada, East Godavari, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (1 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
